Pajama factory on strike! Globe presents musical theatre favorite

An all-out strike at the Sleep Tite Pajama Factory is set to start Thursday, Nov. 19 unless both sides in this drawn-out dispute can come to some agreement over a potential seven and a half cent raise for underpaid workers.

Such is the premise for Georgetown Globe Production's latest musical theatre offering, Richard Bissell's *The Pajama Game* which opens Thursday at the John Elliott Theatre with a Gala Reception following the performance.

General manager Myron Hasler in a bid to stem worker unrest has hired veteran time study expert Vernon Hines and newly appointed Superintendent Sid Sorokin. Reaction from Local 343 of the Garment Workers' Union is mixed: while Grievance Committee chair Babe Williams is bound and determined to push for a full work stoppage and walk-out by week's end, the president of the union is looking to arrive at a speedy settlement with local management.

Resident nominated for Governor-General award

Georgetown resident, Sandra Shamas, known throughout Canada for her one-woman comedy show, has been nominated for the prestigious Governor General's Literary Awards.

Shamas's book, *A Trilogy of Performances*, has been nominated in the English-language Drama category. Besides Shamas, there are four other works nominated in that category. Shamas's book has also been nominated for the Stephen Leacock Award for Humor.

Shamas has transposed three of her hit comedy acts to the pages of her book. The trilogy is made up of the following shows: *My Boyfriend's Back* and *There's Gonna be Laundry*, *My Boyfriend's Back* and *There's Gonna be Laundry 2: The Cycle Continues* and *Wedding Bell Hell*.

According to a press release from Mercury Press Publishers, these shows have been retired from the stage, and the only way to experience them is through Shamas's book.

Fifty-six French and English works have been nominated in seven categories for the awards, which are organized by the Canada Council for the Arts and sponsored by the

Bank of Montreal.

Winners, selected by independent peer juries, will be announced on Tuesday (Nov. 17). Governor General of Canada Romeo LeBlanc will be presenting the winners with their prizes later that night at Rideau Hall in Ottawa.
