It appears that revised tax bills for the commercial and industrial sector will have to be re-sent to approximately 550 locations in Halton Hills. Provincial rules have changed again.

Recently at regional council we were updated on the situation. Current value assessment and the associated impacts along with the pooling, downloading and changes have not been smooth.

The municipalities, the region and all the chambers of commerce have asked the provincial government to respect Halton's solution to manage provincial change. Our request cannot be accommodated. Assessment appeal dates have been extended to December 1998.
