

Glen cub's painting earns place in Scouts calendar

A Scouts Canada panel chose 14 pieces of artwork out of more than 150 submissions to grace the pages of the calendar and winners came from across Canada. Dobson is one of five youths from Ontario whose artwork is featured. His drawing is on the January, 2000 page of the calendar.

The 10-year-old's drawing shows a forest, mountains and a waterfront. There are children swim-

ming and camping, having fun in an outdoor setting. He drew this because he wanted a picture with lots of action, he says, and camping is one of the best things about Cubs.




Dobson's leaders Bill Chapman, Karen Van Kooten and Allyson Schira are happy that a local cub from their pack is in the calendar.





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
