

De Kleer has purposely kept graphics to a minimum on his site, limiting them to pictures of the products and the company logo.

"On line, people have short attention spans," he said. "If something takes too long to load, they'll go somewhere else."

De Kleer said on-line shopping provide many advantages for the customer: there is n pressure to buy, it saves time and informatio is available on every product. De Kleer sai convenience is another big factor.

"People are busy though the day and the don't always have time to shop," de Kleer said "If it's 10 p.m. when they get a free momen they can go on-line and find something."

One of the concerns about shopping on lin is making purchases with credit card numbers To solve that problem de Kleer has has linke up with an Oakville company called Interne Secure. When a purchase is being made, cus tomers are temporarily moved from On Lin Golf's page to Internet Secure's page. It collect the information and processes it directly through the bank.

"I never see (the customer's) credit care number, Internet Secure never sees their credi card number," de Kleer said. "It's top of the line security. It's very safe."


