Light in the Darkness outlines the human rights work of Amnesty members all over the world. Last June, a film crew visited the home of local member Linn Kingston, where her group was holding their monthly meeting. About five minutes of the special shows them signing letters of appeal to foreign leaders and discussing Prisoners of Conscience—people detained simply for expressing their beliefs, who have never used nor advocated violence.

The film also shows the emotional arrival of their own Prisoner of Conscience at Pearson Airport last April, following his release from a Cuban prison. Guillermo Samba was arrested five years ago for charging that the 1993 Cuban elections were unfair, since only one party could run. After Amnesty groups in Georgetown, Ireland, and Belgium deluged Cuban President Fidel Castro with letters, Samba was released and exiled to Canada.

Georgetown group members waited with Samba's family and national media through 14 hours of plane delays until he finally entered the airport arrivals area, proclaiming in halting English "free at last, free
