


'Should the Canadian government have been involved in getting convicted kidnappers David Spencer and Christine Lamont returned to Canada from Brazil?'

you do the time."




Michael Baron, real estate, Georgetown

"I agree with that. I think they have a right to be punished here because they're Canadian citizens. They would have a better chance for rehabilitation here. From a rights human point of view, it's better."




Diane Costa, sales, Georgetown
