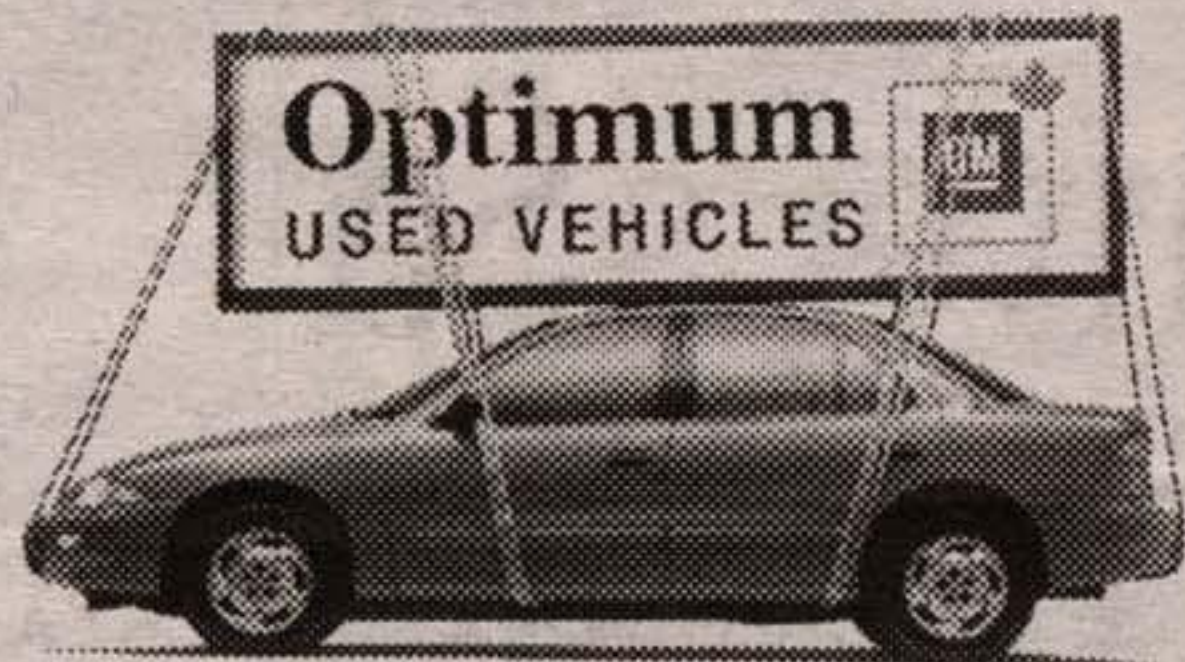


## Community services directory available

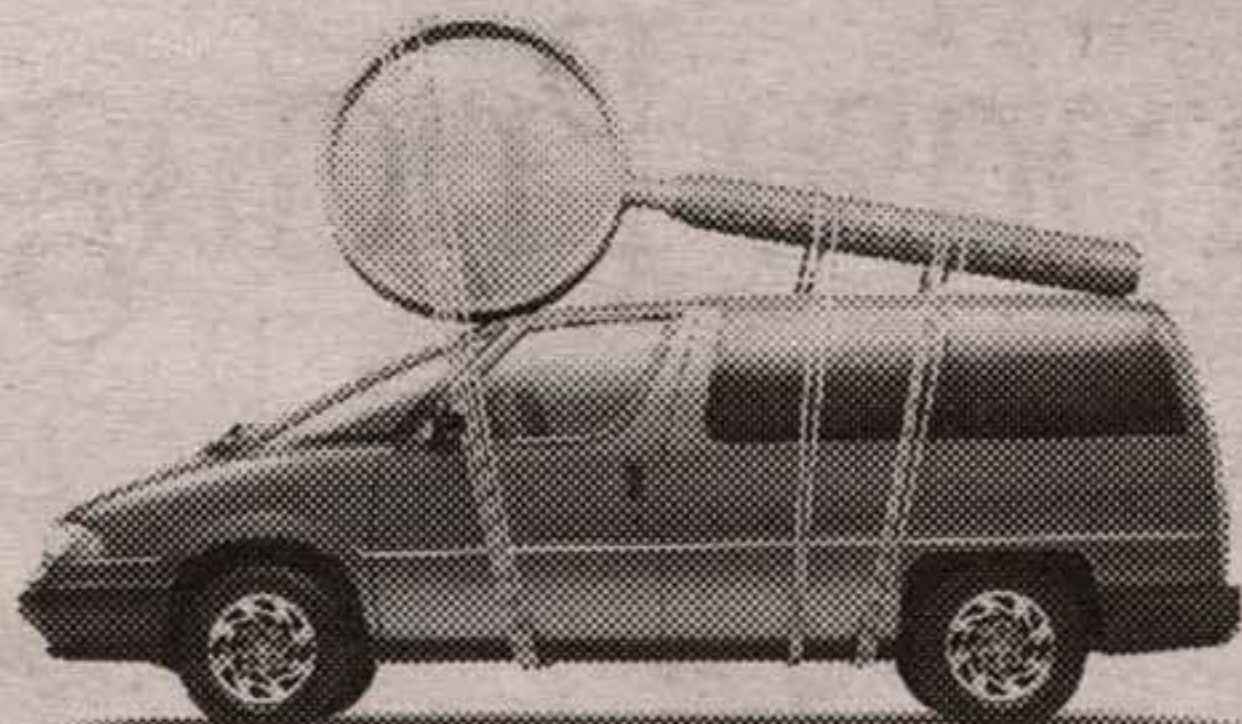

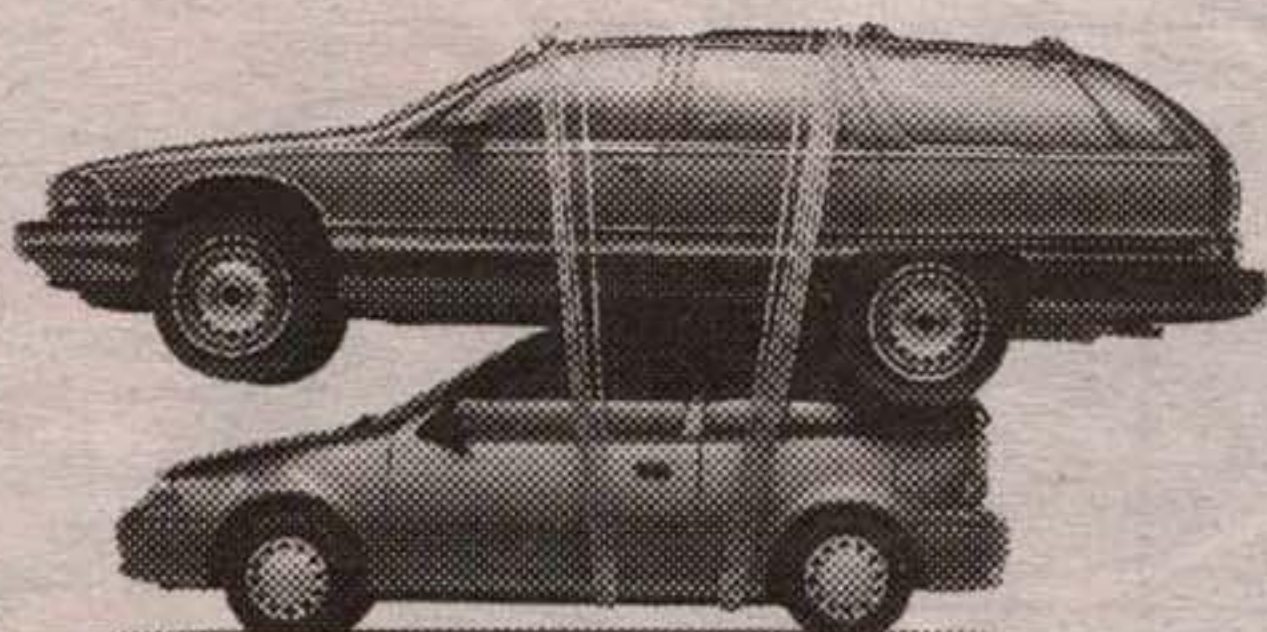
