Computer viruses almost fixed

Public school report cards will be on time

Halton District School Board officials have almost caught up with computer viruses that had threatened to delay elementary school report cards.

"At two or three schools, there has been a big impact and there is difficulty accessing corrupt files," Superintendent Keith Johnson said in a recent interview.

"The remainder of the schools will meet the timelines for reporting. The potential for delay has been minimized."

Elementary school report cards

are due at the end of November.

Board officials want to meet the deadline so parents have report cards for Dec. 4 parent-teacher interviews. That date is a PA day which cannot be altered.

Johnson said the viruses were specifically affecting Apple computers in the elementary system. The board's secondary schools, which are in a PC environment, were not affected.

He said 10 schools were significantly infected by viruses, but the numbers have been reduced through cleaning and scanning.

"We have updated and put in more sophisticated virus software,

with the latest inoculations for viruses," noted Johnson. "You pay more for the software, but there's a far greater sense of protection."

Board staff originally thought problems were due to a six-year old North American virus that attaches to operating systems and is activated by a time clock. But two additional viruses were discovered.

Staff and outside computer experts have been working to fix the problem. "We're going to maximize the dollars spent by combining this with regular maintenance that has to be done," noted Johnson.


