

## Ex-police chief tops list Halton's \$100,000 club members

Several public sector employees working in Halton earned more than \$100,000 last year.

The salaries were recently released in accordance with the Public Sector Salary Disclosure Act.

Of those 1998 top-earner public employees at Halton Region, Halton Police Chief Peter Campbell led the pack with a \$130,275 salary. Deputy Police Chief Ean Algar (who took over as chief this year) earned \$107,853 last year.

Halton Region Commissioner of Health Robert Nosal earned \$115,437, Halton CAO Brent Marshall earned \$108,010, and Commissioner of Corporate Services Joseph Rinaldo made \$104,846. Brian O'Mara, Crown Attorney for Halton was paid \$120,357 last year.

There were several \$100,000+ earners at both Halton school boards as well.

Top earners at Halton District School Board last year were; Director of Education Dusty Papke who made \$129,039, and superintendents Paul Anthony, Gerry Cullen, Keith Johnson, Wayne McNally and Catharine Rankin who each earned \$103,746.

At the Halton Roman Catholic District School Board, Director of Education Fred Sweeney made \$120,477 last year, Superintendent of Human Resources Steve Balogh earned \$106,930, Superintendent of Business/Treasurer Joseph Birett made \$109,860, Superintendent of Education Luciano Piovesan made \$106,079 and Superintendent of Education Diane Rabenda earned \$103,032.

### Girl, 3, bitten by family dog

A three-year-old girl received a head wound and bite marks on her left hand when she was bitten by the family's dog in the kitchen of her Gilmer Cr. home Friday at about 9 a.m. She was treated by ambulance attendants and taken to Georgetown Hospital. The dog, a 10-year-old Husky-German shepherd cross, was taken by animal control and the family decided to have it put down.

The other is male, East Indian, 5'9", with black curly hair and long sideburns, aged between 23 and 25.

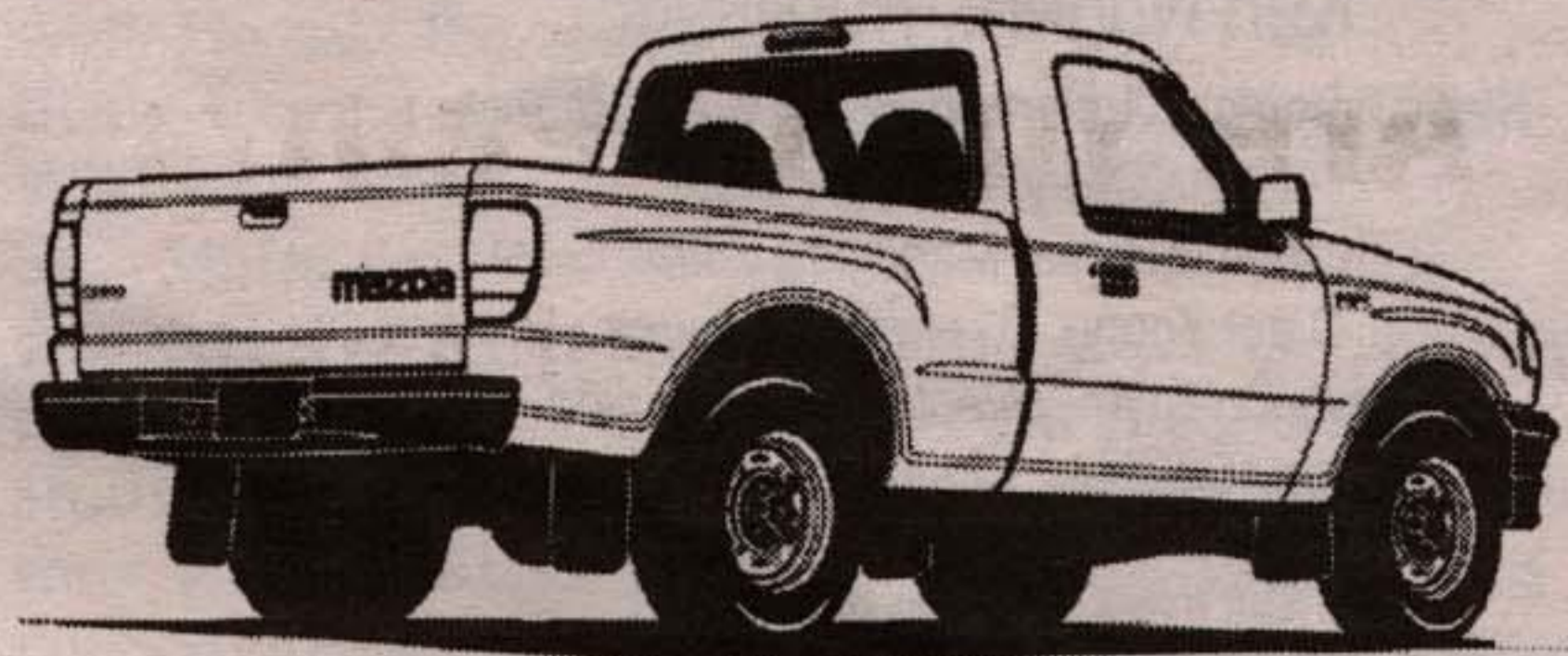
### Army Cadets to hold tag days April 15-19
