# Select Raiders clip Brampton 3-1

Teven Select Raiders Trevor Hill scored twice and Brock Hamilton had another In the Georgetown Re/Max Blue Springs Seven Select Raiders' 3-1 win over Brampton. Matt Sargent had two assists.

In other games, Chad Fellows capitalized on a breakaway for the only Raider goal in a 1-1 tie with Bolton. Georgetown played to another 1-1 deadlock against Brampton II as Sean Wittman scored.

The Raiders also pounded Orangeville 5-1. Fellows and Robert Turner each scored a pair and Dylan Hanzelka added another. Justin Reid had two assists. Fellows scored four times, all set up by Hill, in a 5-1 win over Caledon. Kody Lyons had the other goal. Sargent collected three assists. Two disallowed goals ended the Raiders' winning ways as they were edged 3-2 by Brampton II. Fellows and Hill scored for Georgetown.

Goalies Marc Drake and Marcus Rees allowed only eight goals in six games.

#### **Atom II Raiders**

A.J. Syme scored and set up two more goals as the Georgetown Atom II Raiders edged Orangeville 4-3.

Brett Maltby, Scott Buist and Alex Ingangaro had the other Raider goals. Picking up assists were Joel Greaves, Jesse Swain, Spencer Malcovich, Eric McClure and Justin Bolton.

In exhibition play, the Raiders tied Bolton 5-5. Ingangaro, Syme and Dan Rankin each had a goal and an assist. Swain and Buist also

scored. Earning assists were Mike Brown and Matt Turner. The Raiders then dropped a 6-2 decision. Greaves and Syme scored with helpers going to Bolton, Buist, Rankin and Brown.


