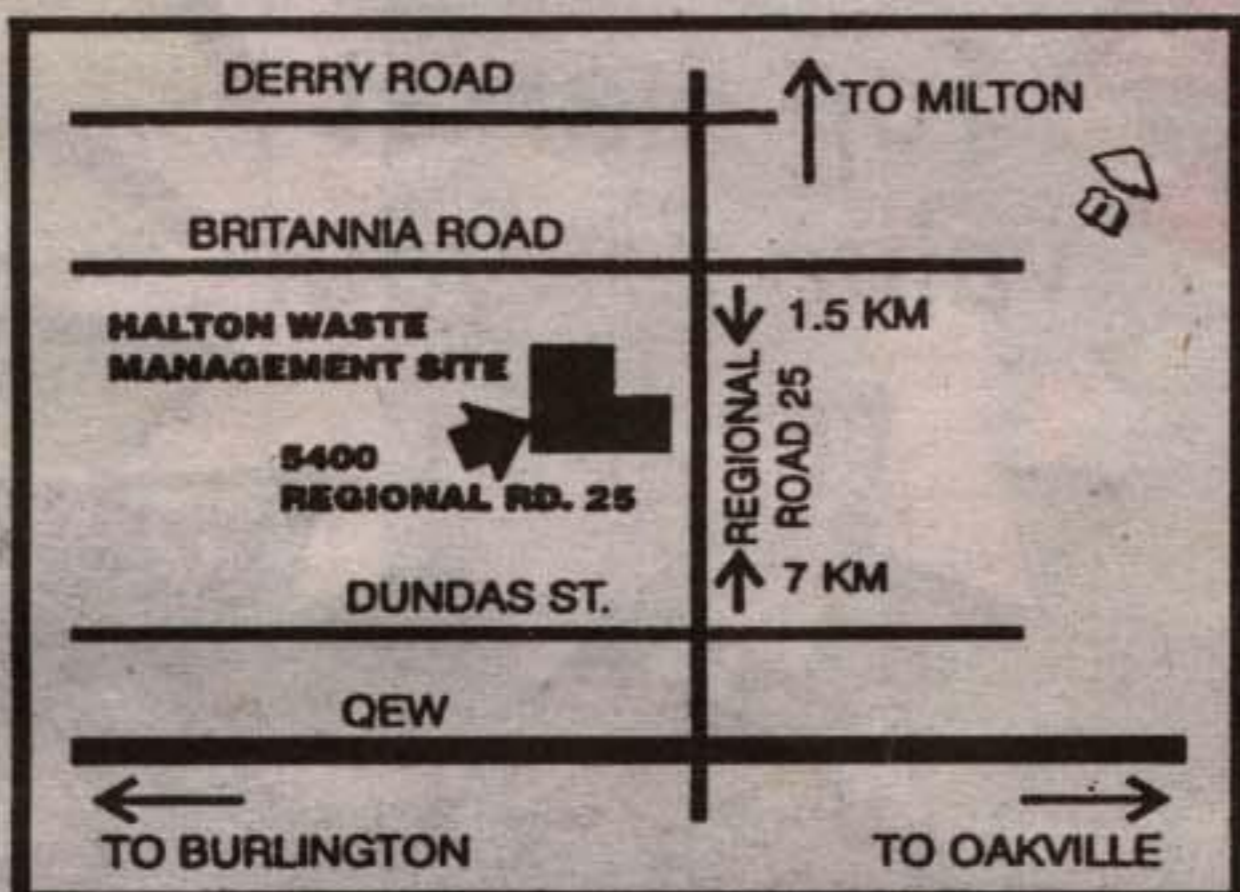

- Tires are **not** collected as part of the Region's regular or bulk waste collection programs

Fine wine up for bid

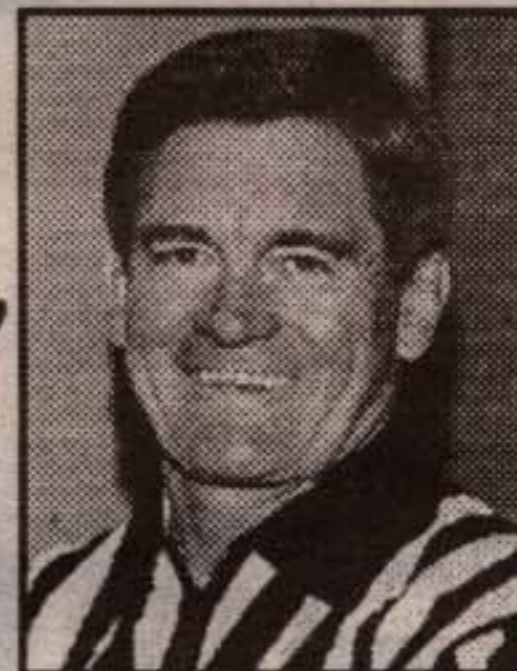

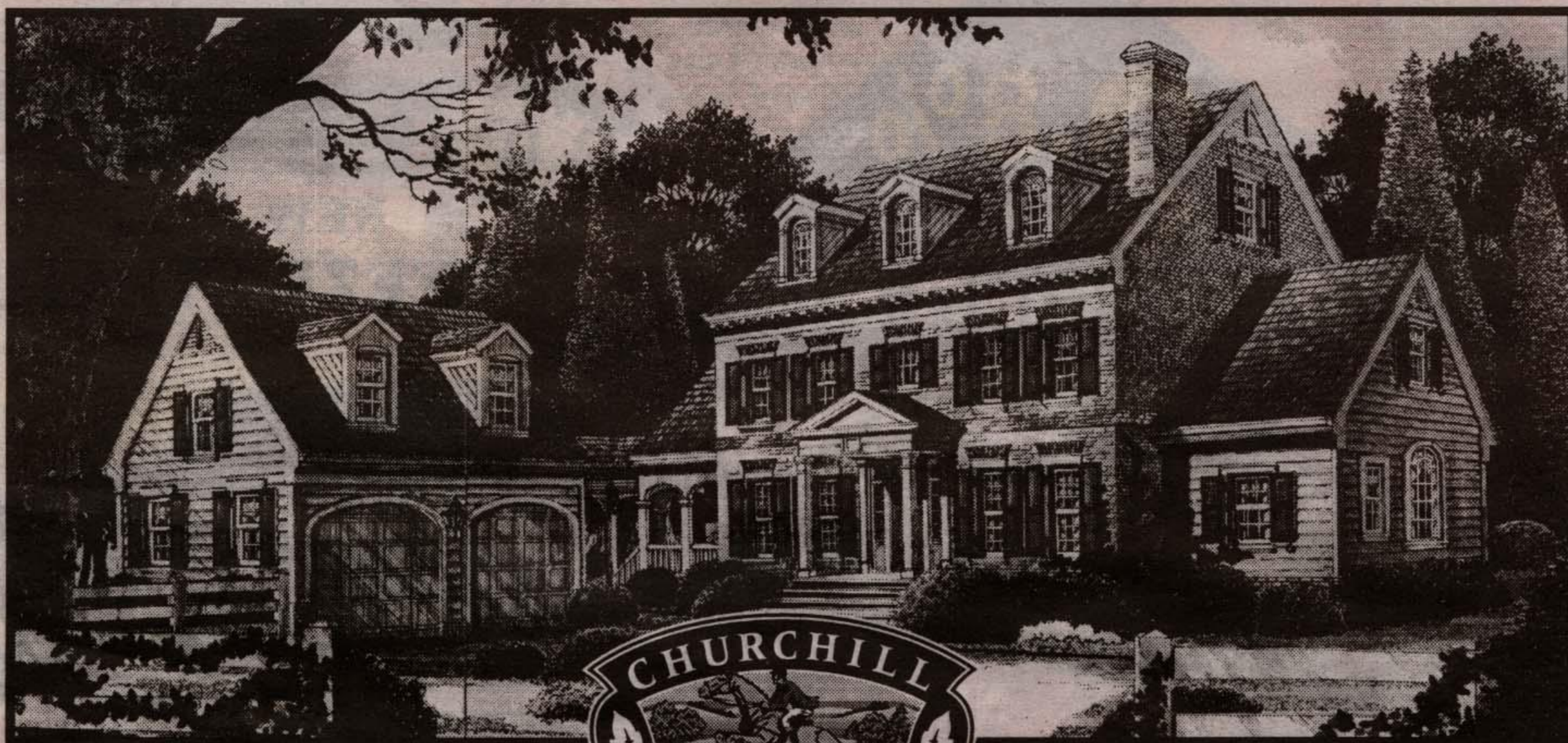

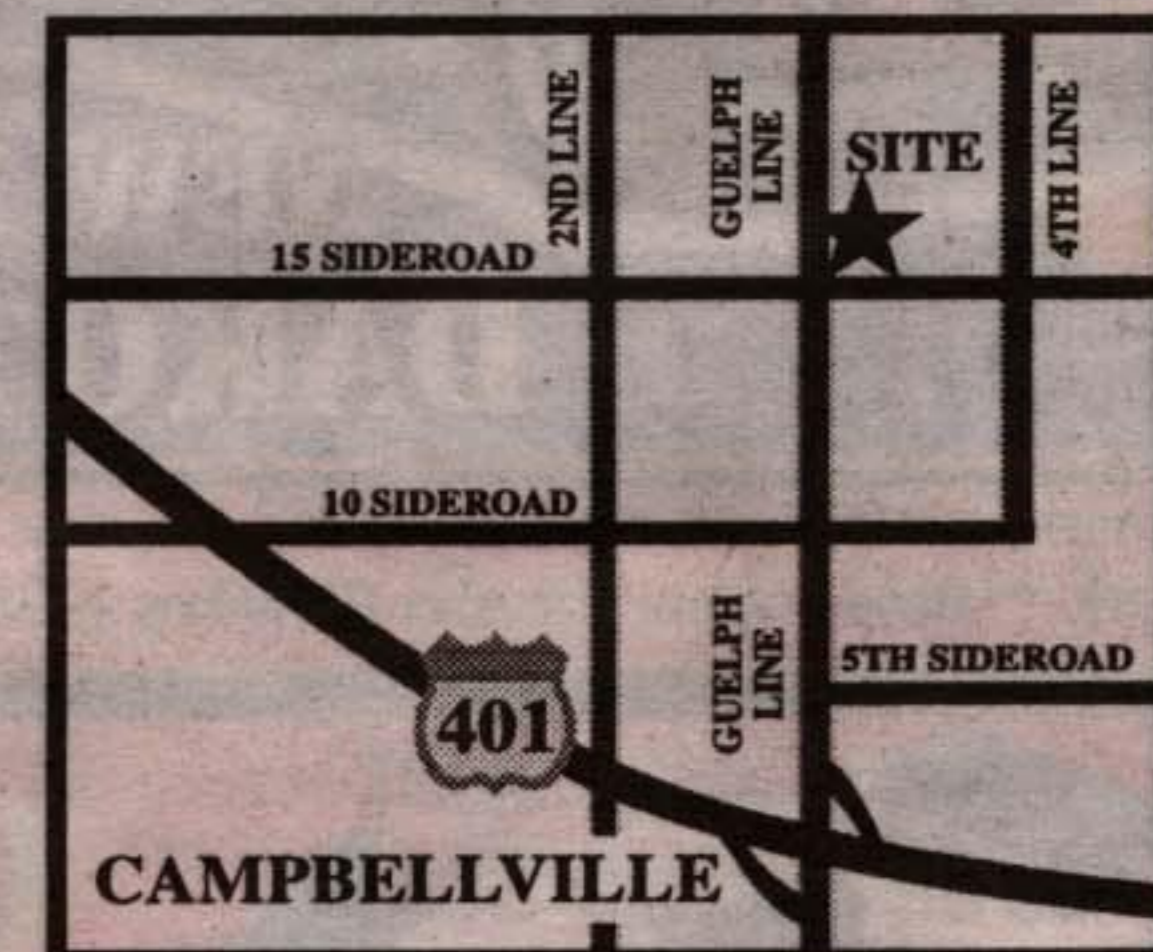
