Bulldogs' losing streak reaches four

Bricknell, usually counted on for leadership in areas other than offence, was an unlikely candidate to spark the Bulldogs. He had three goals in Friday's 12-8 loss to the Sarnia Pacers and two goals in Thursday's 16-6 loss to the Spartan Warriors.

The Sarnia loss was a complete reversal of the Milton game, with the Bulldogs collapsing in the third. Leading 7-6, Georgetown surrendered six goals in the final

10 minutes. A double minor touched off a Sarnia spree of four goals in 2:05.

The promising aspect of the weekend was that the Bulldogs had players step up their games to fill the void created by numerous injuries. Bricknell had nine goals and 12 points over the three games, Matt Jackson had three points in each contest and Brad Marshall netted a hat-trick against Milton. Even defensive specialist Andrew Craig got in on the act, with goals against both Spartan

and Sarnia.

DOG BITES: The Bulldogs are expected to be back at full strength by Friday but face another weekend of three games in four days....The Bulldogs play in Guelph on Thursday, in Wallaceburg on Friday and then host Owen Sound on Sunday. Game time is 1 p.m. at Memorial Arena...Matt Jackson scored in all three games, including two against Milton....Sean Hardcastle got his first Jr. B goal against Spartan.

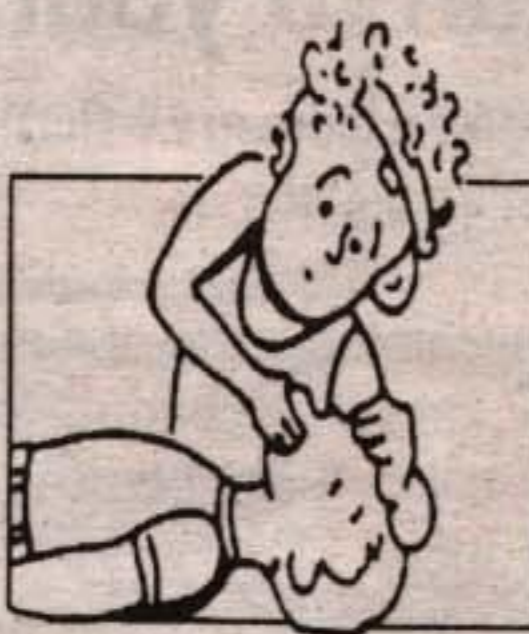
RESCUE BREATHING

CHECK - TILT - BLOW

CHECK for breathing - Shake and shout (gently). Ask "are you okay?" If no response activate Emergency Medical System (call 911 or police) and:



TILT the HEAD & **LIFT** the CHIN. **LOOK** to see if the chest is rising/falling.



LISTEN for the sound of breathing. With your hand or cheek **FEEL** for air escaping from mouth/nose. Not breathing? **PINCH** the nose, **SEAL** the mouth with your mouth and



BLOW 2 slow breaths to inflate the lungs. Look, listen, feel. Continue with one breath every 5 seconds until someone takes over or the person revives.

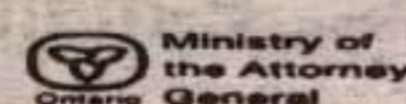
