In this era of high tech childbirth, an age-old concept is re-Lemerging, having a doula present to help the woman and her partner throughout labor and birth.

The word doula comes from ancient Greek and refers to a trained and experienced woman who provides continuous physical, emotional and informational support to a woman before, during and immediately following childbirth.

The doula's encouragement, reassurance and practical knowledge of comfort measures and labor enhancing techniques can decrease pain and anxiety for the laboring mother. The doula works together with the family and medical staff to meet the individual needs of her client and her family. Fathers present in labor appreciate the guidance and assistance of doulas.




