- Do not use water or flush toilets between the times indicated on your blue letter which we will provide to you approximately 2 days prior to working on your street.
- When we are finished for the day on your street, turn on the cold water tap in your basement and let the water run until clear. This may create air in your system, and if so, go to the highest point in your home and turn the cold water tap on and let it run until the air is out of the line.
