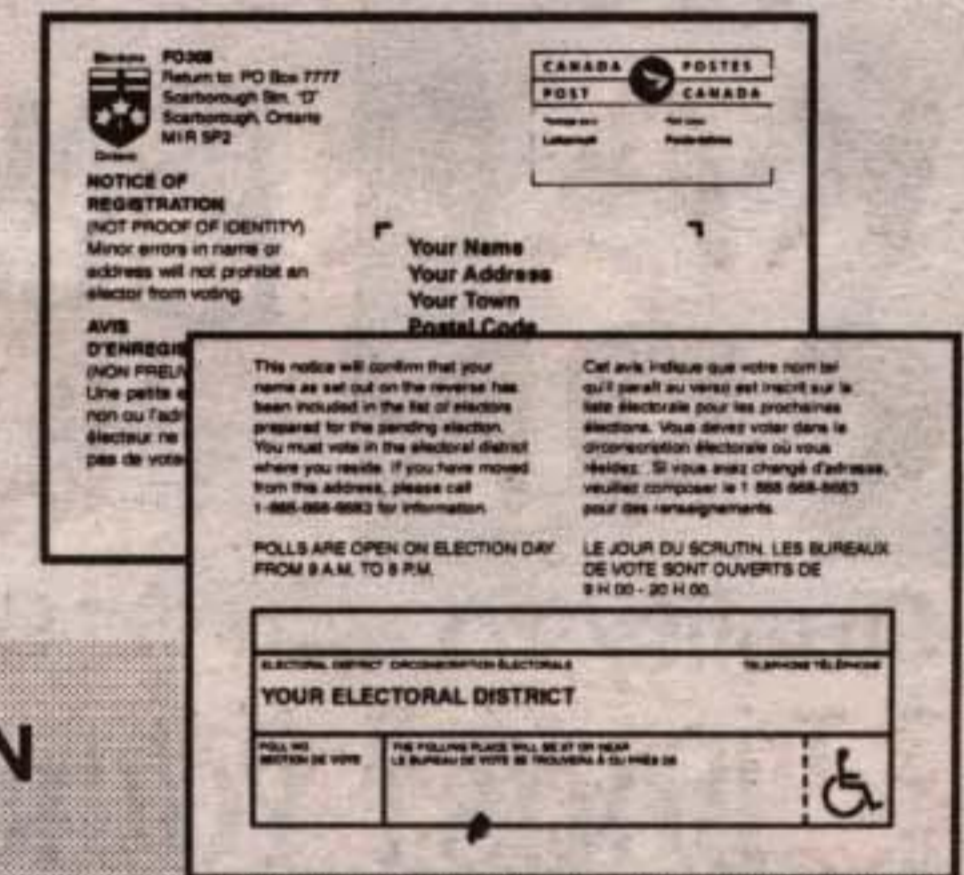
# ONTARIO PROVINCIAL ELECTION

## Be Sure You Can Vote!

To vote on June 3rd, your name must be on the List of Voters.

Most Ontario voters will be receiving the Notice of Registration card that is being mailed out over the next few days. It confirms that they are on the Voters List for this election.

If you are qualified to vote and DO NOT receive your Notice of Registration card, be sure to apply for a Certificate to Vote by 8:00 p.m. on June 2nd, the day before election day.

The phone numbers for electoral district returning offices are available from Directory Assistance. If you require information specific to your electoral district, ask for "Elections Ontario" and then the electoral district by name. ### NEW ELECTORAL DISTRICTS

The boundaries for electoral districts in Ontario provincial elections have changed. The number of electoral districts has gone from 130 to 103 and boundaries are now the same as those for federal elections.

You may confirm your electoral district by calling Elections Ontario or by visiting our website.

### QUALIFICATIONS TO VOTE

To be eligible to vote, on polling day a person must be:

- 18 years of age,
- a Canadian citizen, and
- a resident of the electoral district.

Persons who ceased to live in Ontario within the two years before polling day may be entitled to vote under certain conditions. Call us for further information.

If you have friends or relatives who have difficulty reading, please make them aware of the information in this notice.
