HUMMINGBIRD FEEDER TIPS

The best feeder mixture is made up of 1 part sugar and 4 parts boiling water. Cool and store in refrigerator. Never use honey, artificial sweeteners or red food dye in your solution. Protect your feeder from the wind and the hot sun that may cause dripping or spoilage. Maintain a clean feeder. Wash it in hot water every 2 or 3 days and refill with fresh solution to keep your visiting hummers healthy. You can keep ants out by using ant traps or Vaseline on the wire holding the feeder. Festival of Music winners

Alyssa Hait of Georgetown earned the Kiwanis Club of Georgetown Award for placing first overall at the Halton Hills Festival of Music held earlier this month in Norval.
