

SOS group plans general meeting on bypass tonight

SOS (Save Our Streets), the Hall Rd. neighborhood citizen's group which formed after learning about a potential highway bypass along Hall Rd. to 10th Line, will hold a general interest meeting tonight (Sept. 8).

The meeting, for all interested citizens of the Hall Rd. neighborhood which includes Baylor, Chelvin, Fagan, Flamingo, Guelph,

Hall, Rosefield, Roydon, Russell and Wilson streets, is an organizational meeting to strengthen the residents' input into the upcoming environmental assessment (EA) study on the highway bypass.

The residents object to their area's inclusion as a possible north-south road bypass for Hwy. 7 traffic.

While regional staff have sug-

gested Hall Rd. may be ruled out early in the EA study, "it is absolutely imperative that we continue a well-organized input to the regional transportation study," said a SOS press release.

The meeting will be held at the Royal Ascot Condominium, 26 Hall Rd., starting at 7 p.m. The agenda includes updates and the formation of executive and sub-committee.

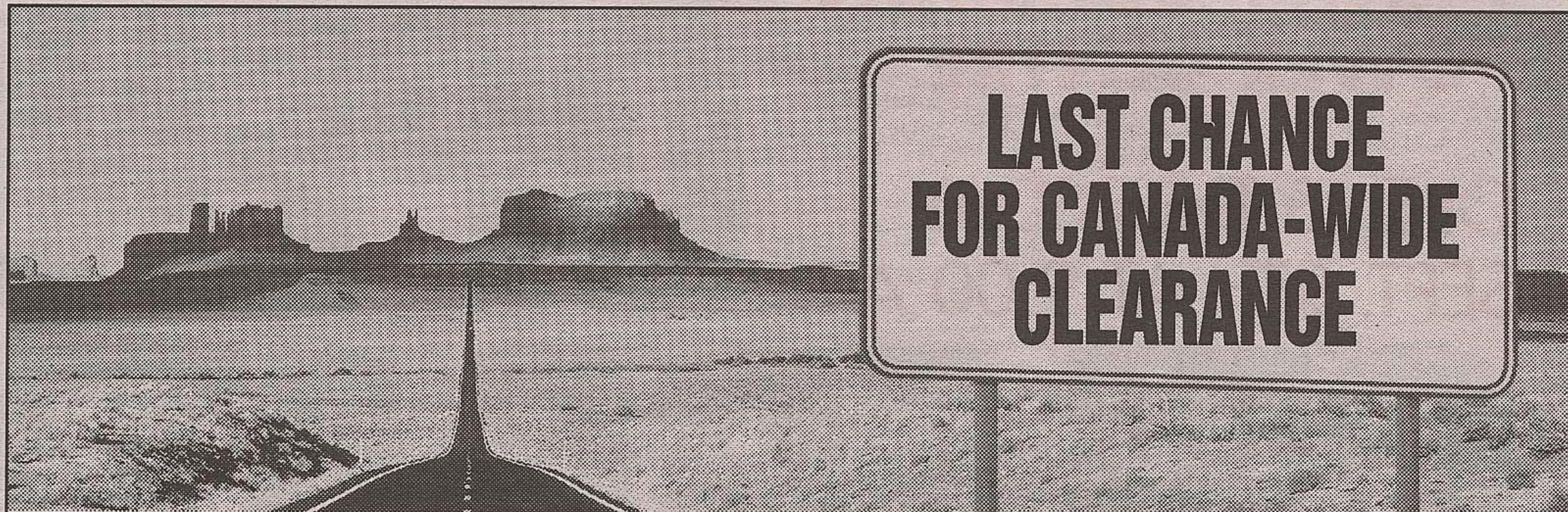

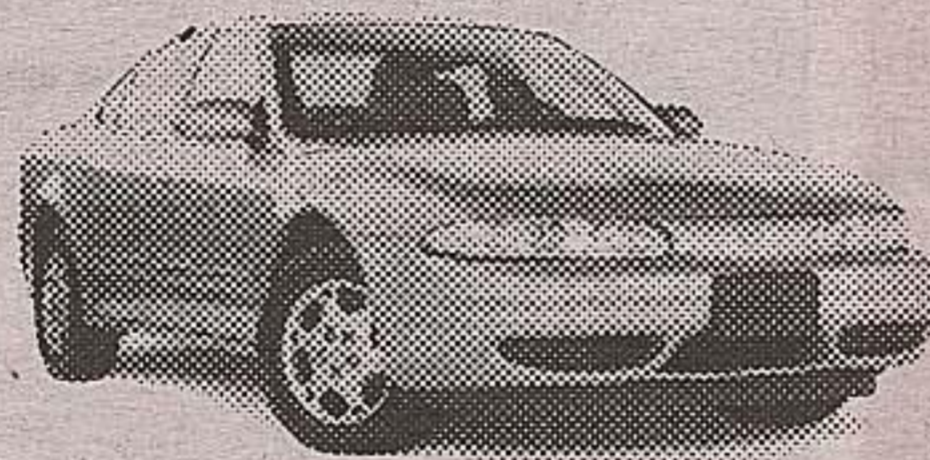

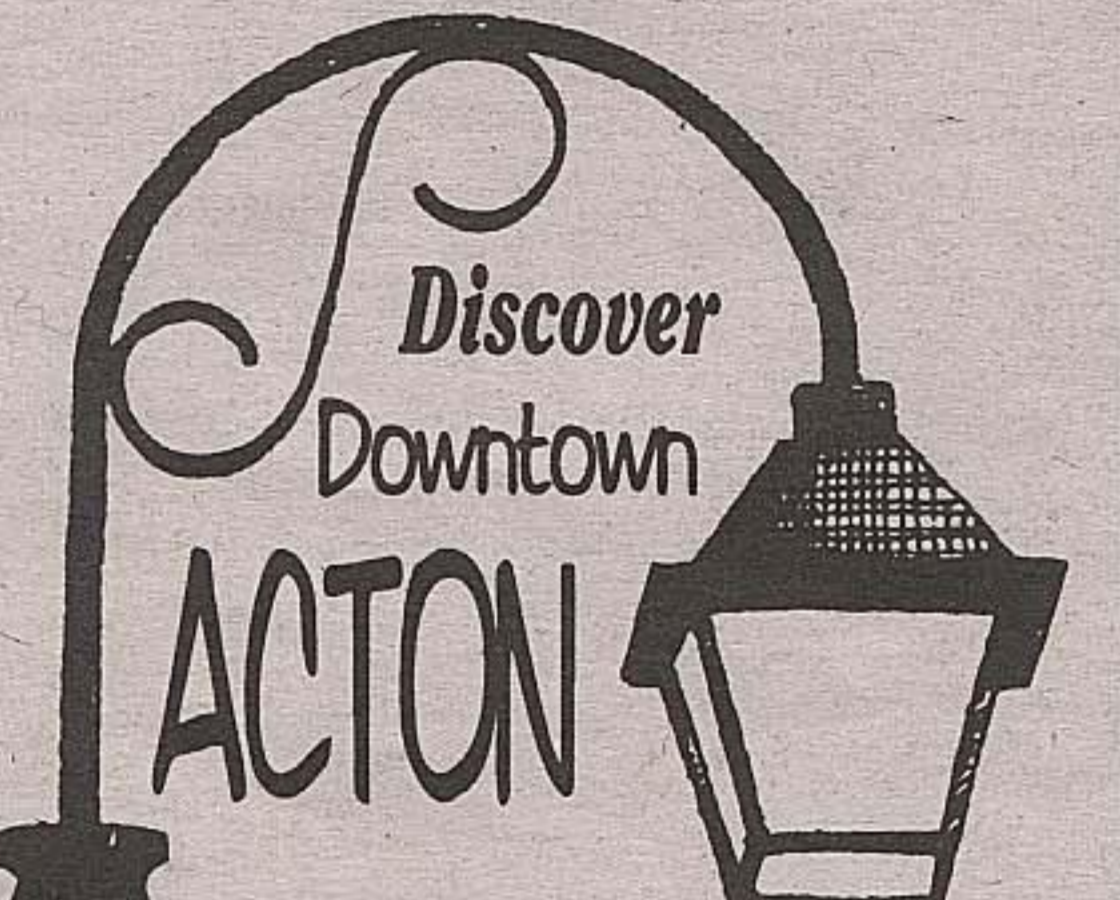
