Juried art show at Halton Hills Cultural Centre Deadline nears for Re:VISION entries

Artists who want to participate in Here and Now 1999, have until Tuesday, Sept. 21, to submit an entry.

The annual show, presented by Re:VISION unlimited arts, is a juried art exhibition, Sept. 30 to October 24 in the Gallery of the Halton Hills Cultural Centre. Selections will be made by judge John Sommer.

Artists may submit up to three works of original works completed during the year. Works previously displayed in Georgetown are not eligible.

Eligible works include paintings (oil, acrylic, watercolor), drawings, original graphics, photographs, mixed media, fiber art, three dimensional works in bronze, stone, clay, plastics, etc.

Works must be suitably framed (only white mats accepted) or otherwise prepared for the display.

A non-returnable entry and handling fee of \$6 must accompany each submission. A label showing artist's name, address, telephone number, title of work, medium and retail price of the work must be attached to the back of the work. A second set of labels and "artist information" must be mailed to Dawn Schertzl, RR1 Norval, Ontario, LOP 1K0. For more information call Schertzl at 873-4438. The deadline for mailing is Sept. 21.

All submitted works must be for sale. A 25 per cent commission on each work sold during the exhibition will be subtracted.

Cultural Centre on Monday, Sept. 27, between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

The official opening of the exhibition takes place Saturday, Oct. 2, 2-5 p.m.

Seven artists show at The Forge Gallery
