





Internet helps Georgetown company succeed in international marketplace

n less than two years, sales at EAP Quality Assurance LConsultants in Georgetown have grown at a rapid pace.

Brian Coleman, who started the company last February and runs it out of his home, said during the first year in business sales were about \$45,000 and this year they are projected to be about \$500,000. In light of the growth he has recently brought his brother Duane, also of Georgetown, on board.

The company provides a software program to help facilitate the management of an Employee's Assistance Program (EAP) company and most of their customers are based in the U.S.

"Sixty per cent of our business is in the U.S. By next year it will probably be 90 per cent," said Coleman.

Their first client was the New York Times. They also have clients in Canada and Britain and many of them come to them by way of the Internet.

"We would not be where we are today without the Internet," said Coleman. "The Internet has really moved this along."

He said the company gets one or two hits each day on its Web site and has received information requests from as far away as Taipei, Pakistan, Australia, New Zealand, Lithuania, Sweden and Mexico.

Coleman, who worked for Warren Shepell Consultants (an EAP company) in Toronto for 10 years before he ventured out on his own, said there are about two or three competitors in the U.S. that offer a product similar to his.

He and colleague Glenn Scott decided to develop the software program while working at Warren Shepell because they were unable to find a program to meet their needs. Scott now has a less active role in the company.

Coleman worked with three computer science students to

develop the program, and said most of the interaction with them was done through email.


