

## Two-day photo contest is on next weekend

Once again, Halton Hills Camera Club is holding their annual Capture the Hills 99 photo competition, Sept. 25 and 26.

After registering at Halton Camera Exchange September 25, competitors shoot a 24 exposure roll of film provided with the \$25 entry fee, within the boundaries of Halton Hills on one or both days. When the roll is completed, it is dropped off at Halton Camera Exchange by 10 p.m. September 26 to be processed and picked up October 1 or 2.

There are three categories in the competition: 1. People, creatures and critters, 2. Scenery, foliage and flowers, and 3. Halton Hills Heritage.

All photos must be taken within the geographic boundaries of Halton Hills, between 7 a.m. September 25 and 10 p.m. September 26.

After receiving their proofs, contestants can enter a maximum of six prints with no more than two in each category. There are ten prizes awarded, and judging is completed by a team of judges selected by Halton Camera Exchange.

An awards presentation night will be held at the Halton Hills Civic Centre October 21, at 7 p.m. at which time all submitted prints will be displayed, as well as the winners announced.
