# Post office box battered

At about 3 a.m. Thursday some Acton residents in the area of Wallace St. and Main St. heard a loud bang. A man was seen on Main St. carrying a baseball bat. It was later discovered that a post office box had been forced open and the contents had been removed.

#### Cars vandalized

About \$400 worth of damage was caused to a 1995 Toyota CR4 parked on Kingham Rd. Tuesday night or Wednesday morning when the rear window was smashed.
