### Portrait drawing every Tuesday

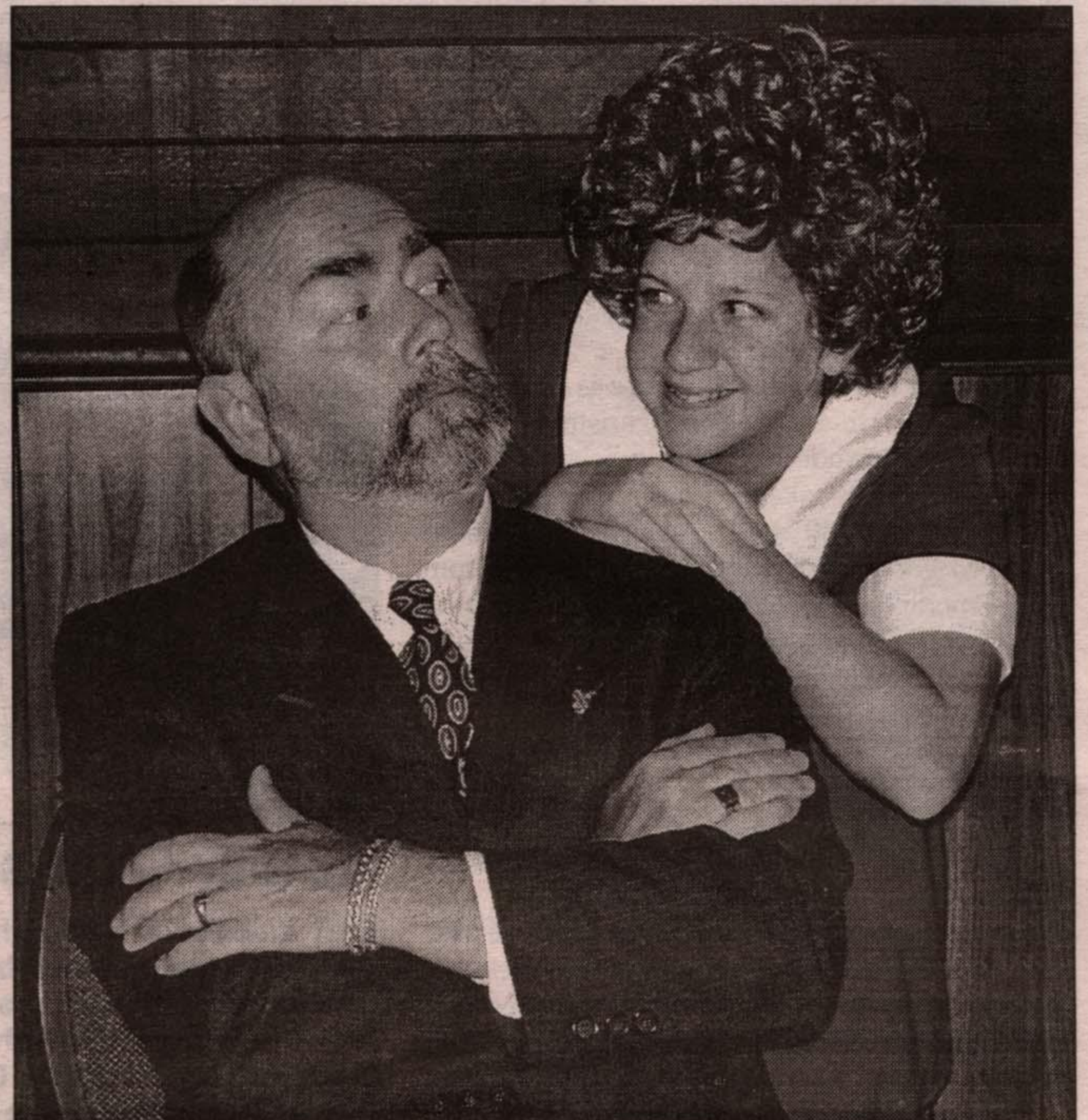
