

Halton Region's Web site now offers three new public services

Visitors to Halton Region's Web site, www.region.halton.on.ca can now access three new services on-line— WhereIs, RepLocator and Halton Career Opportunities.

These services and other regional information are also more quickly accessible due to Halton Region's improved navigation mapping technology.

"Halton Region's Web site is a key source of information

about our programs and services. To help visitors access information more easily, we improved the speed in which information can be downloaded," said Ralph Blauel, Advanced Technology Specialist, Halton Region. "Plus, key services like garbage pickup, council agendas and minutes, maps and contacts, once found at various locations within the site, are now linked to the navigation bar so visitors can access

them immediately from the home page."

In addition to the navigation upgrade, Halton Region added three new services to their Web site: WhereIs, RepLocator and Halton Career Opportunities.

WhereIs is an interactive map tool that locates services within the Region of Halton and displays them on a street map. Search for a specific address or find the location of hospitals, government build-

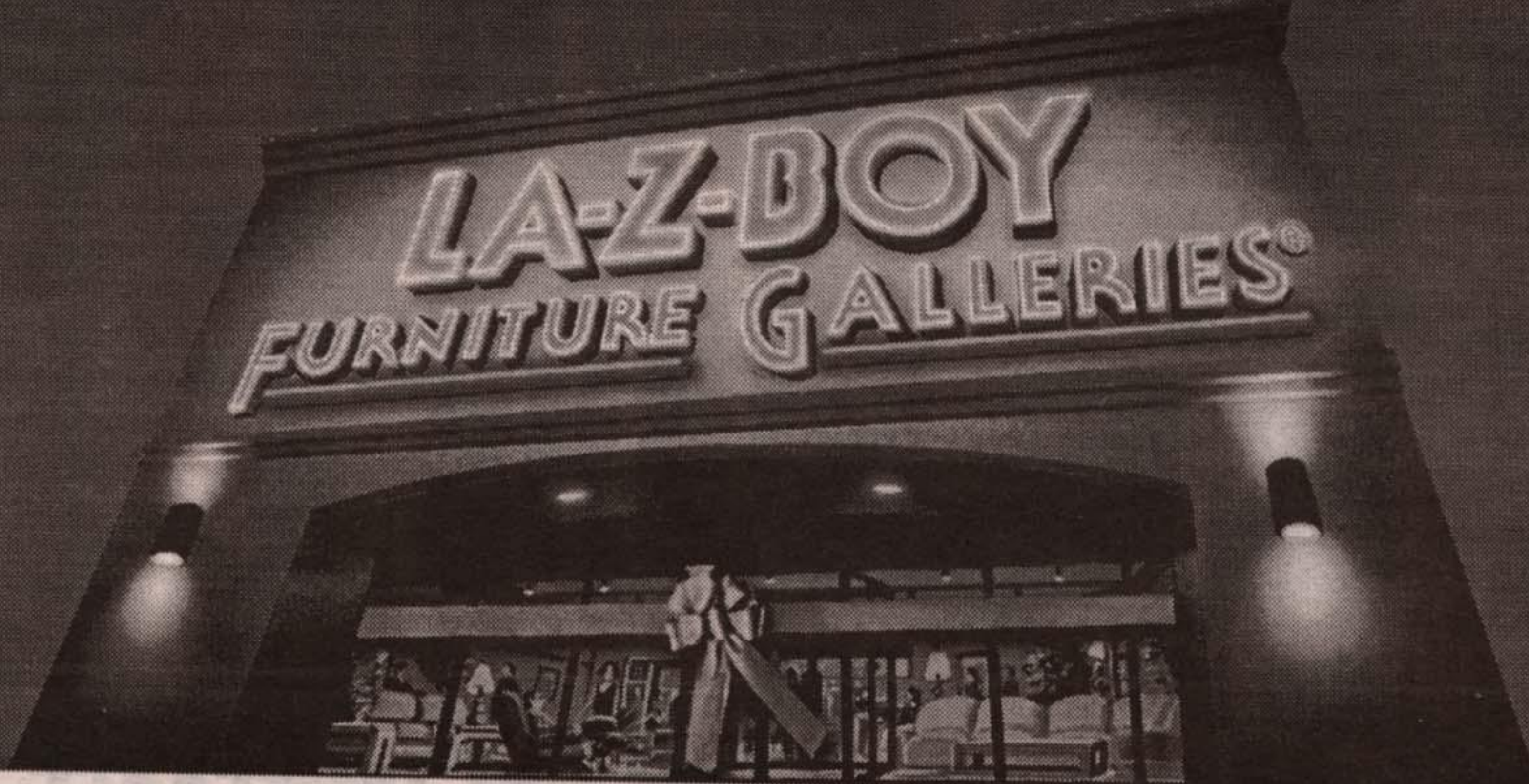
ings, museums, child care centres and more by selecting them from a list and allowing WhereIs to draw them on a map for you. Location and contact information is included and you may pan or zoom in and out of the map for more or less detail.

RepLocator is an interactive search tool that shows you what regional ward you are in, and finds contact information for your school board trustee,

as well as federal, provincial, regional, and local elected representatives. Enter your address and RepLocator draws the location on a map. Click the display button, and RepLocator shows you the contact information.

Halton Career Opportunities is a current listing of positions available at Halton Region. Position descriptions, expiry dates and application information is also included.

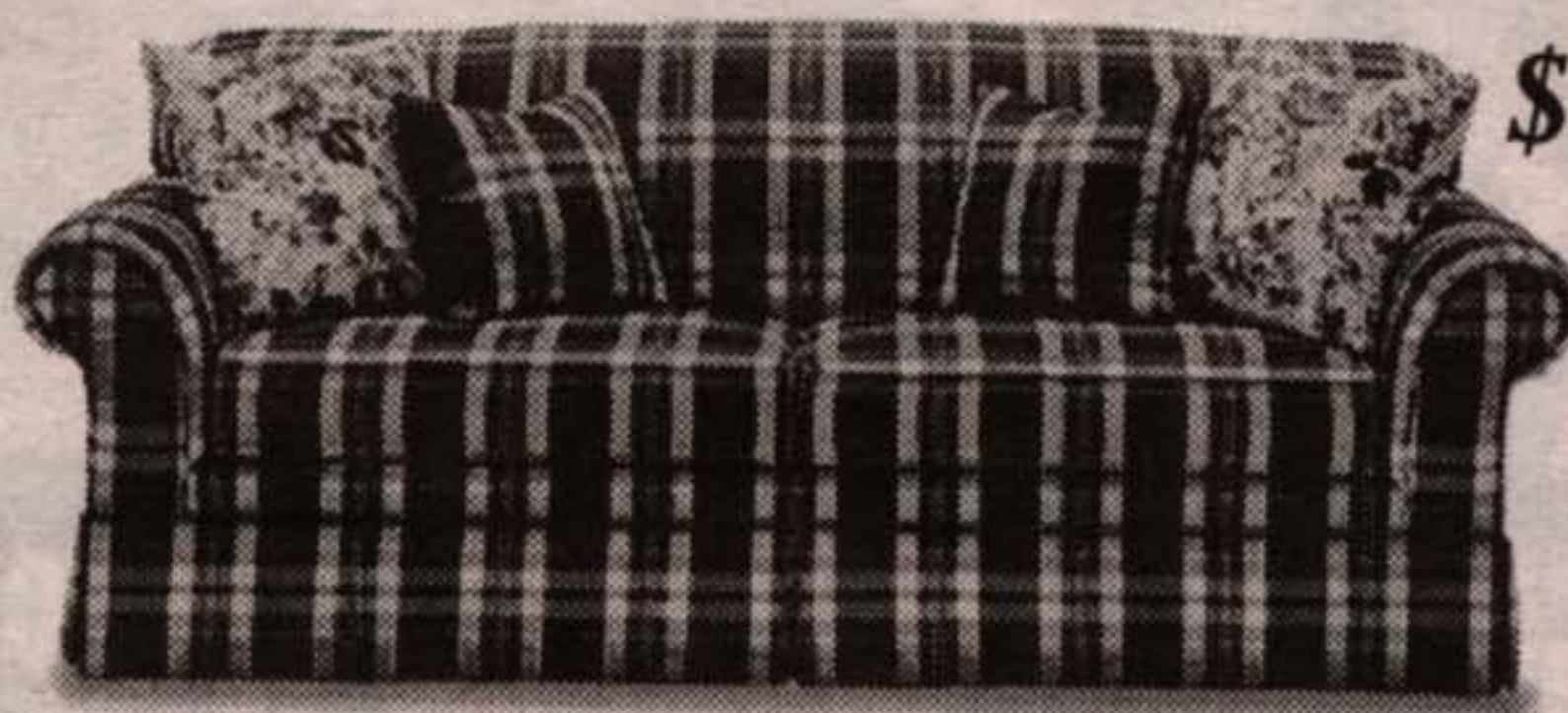

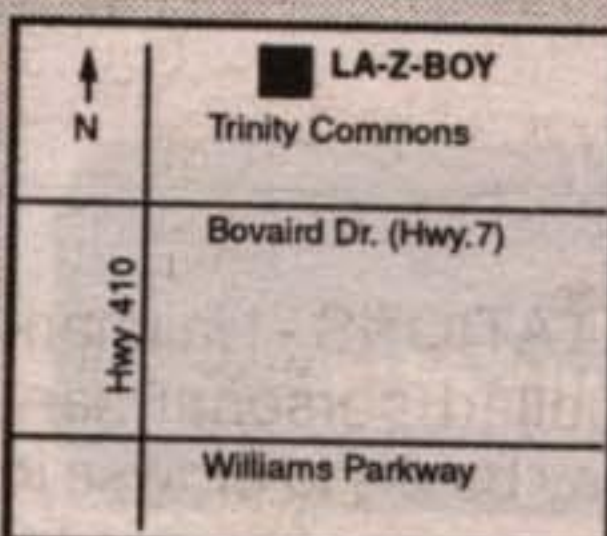

FRONT TEETH ARE VERY VALUABLE!

A front tooth is worth \$309,000 or .12 cents, depending upon how much you figure, according to a survey by the American Association of Endodontists reported in the Chicago Tribune. The materials that go into making up the average tooth—calcium, phosphorous, water etc. cost only about .76 cents to buy. But in a survey of 1,023 men and women taken by the association, people put a much higher value on their teeth. Nearly one-fourth of the respondents said that they wouldn't sell a tooth for anything. About 15 percent said that they'd want at least \$1 million, but the rest were not so demanding and the average asking price from the entire group came out to \$309,000!
