Halton Hills teen faces several charges after woman assaulted

A 16-year-old Halton Hills male is facing several charges after he stole a van and assaulted a woman Sunday evening.

Halton Police say at about 7:15 p.m. the Halton Hills youth and three other male residents of the Spruce Lane Open Custody facility were at a baseball game in Campbellville with a female staff member of the facility.

At 8:30 p.m. when they were getting ready to leave one of the males demanded she give him the keys to the facility's vehicle. When she refused, the male assaulted her and took the keys. He then left the area in the 1999 Ford Windstar van. The other three males attended to the woman and took her to an area home to call police.

Police received a report at 9 p.m. of a van in the ditch on Walkers Line north of Derry Rd.

Uniformed officers and a police services dog secured the area while the dog and members of the Tactical Rescue Unit conducted a search.

Shortly after midnight Monday, a police officer discovered the main gatehouse at Rattlesnake Point Conservation Area had been entered and a 16-year-old male was found inside. He was taken into custody.

While police were taking the youth to a holding facility in Oakville he tried to kick the window out of the cruiser. When police attempted to restrain him he injured an officer by kicking him in the hand.

The youth is charged with robbery, theft over \$5,000, break, enter and theft, unlawfully at large, two counts of breach of probation, and assault cause bodily harm.
