New-look McDonald's to reopen in December

ver the next couple of weeks the McDonald's restaurant on Guelph St. will be demolished to make way for a new and improved version.

Dave Beatty, owner of the 28-year-old restaurant with his wife Lucy, said it will close for good at 11:30 p.m. Monday. After it's torn down a new, larger McDonald's, which will feature 156 seats—double the current number—will be built and is tentatively expected to reopen in the second week of December.

\$1 million to build.

He said it will be "state-of-the-art" and have a play area at the front of the building that includes a large tower for climbing apparatus.

It will also include a tandem drivethru which allows two orders to be taken simultaneously.

He said the new store will have some similarities to the new McDonald's in Bolton but the Georgetown restaurant will be bigger.

"No cost is being spared. It's going to be the nicest McDonald's I've seen, and I've seen them all," said Beatty.

Beatty, who also owns McDonald's decided to build a new McDonald's in said.

town because the current facility was in need of a lot of repairs and because "this is a wonderful town, a wonderful market."

"We just want to make that long-term commitment," he said.

Beatty said the 75 full and part-time staff members at the restaurant will not be laid off during the closure but will be able to work in the McDonald's in Georgetown Wal-Mart or in his Brampton stores.

He said he expects to hire an additional 40 employees in November to work in the new store.

"We welcome everyone to come and restaurants in Brampton, said they visit us at McDonald's in Wal-Mart," he




