Jones ready to leave junior ranks behind

Having played in the junior ranks for almost half his life, Andrew Jones wanted to put an exclamation mark on that stage of his career.

Jones finished fourth at the recent Pan-American Junior Squash Championships in Mexico but it wasn't quite what he hoped for.

"I was a little disappointed," he said. "I was looking for gold or silver and I knew at least silver was in grasp."

Jones lost a close match to George Baltazar, Mexico's top player, 9-5, 9-6, 10-9. He then fell to Brandon Abercrombie of the U.S. in the bronze medal match.

"I just wasn't focused to play my best," said


Jones, who is the fourth-ranked junior in Canada.

Jones also took part in the team event in which Canada placed third behind Mexico and the U.S.

With his junior career behind him, Jones will attend the University of Western Ontario where he'll study kinesiology and play on the school's squash team.

The team will also continue to keep Jones competing at a high level. It is the only Ontario university to play against the top U.S. schools.
