

ooking for something to do during those long, winter evenings? The answer is right here in town at the John Elliott Theatre where Georgetown Little Theatre will present its 40th season of quality, live entertainment.

The subscription series starts in November with the acclaimed drama, On Golden Pond, the love story of Ethel and Norman Thayer who are returning to their summer home on Golden Pond for the 44th year. He is a retired professor, nearing 80, with heart palpitations and a failing memory, but still as tart-tongued, observant and eager for life as ever.

Ethel, 10 years younger and the perfect foil for Norman, delights in all the small things in life. They are visited by their divorced, middle-aged daughter and her dentist fiance, who then go off to Europe, leaving his teenaged son behind for the summer.

The second play of the series is the comedy, Play On!, to be presented in February. Have you ever wondered what went on behind the scenes of a play, or pondered on all the problems that could

Play On! is about a community theatre group attempting to perform a play writ-

ten by a novice, local playwright, who continuously rewrites the play, making it extremely difficult for the cast to keep track of what is happening. This is a hilarious comedy with all sorts of confusion and rib-tickling events that are sure to keep you laughing.

The classic Noel Coward comedy, Blithe Spirit, rounds out the series in April. Charles and Ruth throw a dinner party and just for fun they invite Madame Arcati to perform a seance. Everyone but Charles believes the seance was unsuccessful. Only Charles can see who has returned— his first wife. The machinations of a jealous woman—especially one from beyond the grave— are hilarious. A true Noel Coward comedy is probably one of his best.


Show tickets are \$15 each and will benefit the Halton branch of the Canadian Mental Health Association. Seating is limited to 140.
