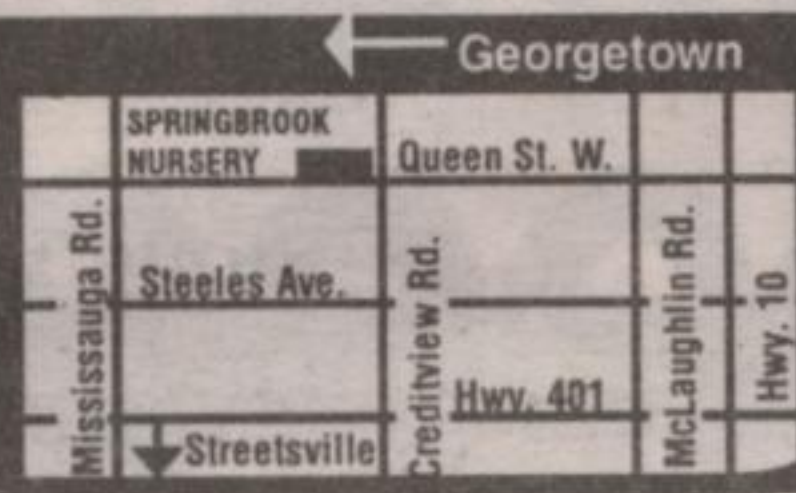

Camera Club holds contest for shutterbugs

The Halton Hills Camera Club will host Capture the Hills 2000, their annual open photographic competition on the September 30 weekend.

The competition takes place over the weekend, and sees up to 100 amateur photographers combing the hills of Halton in the hopes of capturing an award-winning photo.

Rain or shine, the competition involves entrants being given a roll of film and approximately two days to shoot images geared toward three categories. This year's categories are 1. People, creatures and critters, 2. Scenery and architecture and 3. Foliage and flowers.

"This is a great opportunity for people to get out and see some of the things that make Halton Hills a beautiful place to live, work and play. The competition, which coincides with the splendor of fall colours, is the camera club's way of helping to foster appreciation for our area," says camera club member Alan McCord.

The contest starts 7 a.m. on Saturday, September 30, and finishes Sunday, October 1, at 10 p.m. There will be an exhibition of all entries and presentation of prizes to the winners at the Halton Hills Civic Centre, October 26, at 7 p.m.
