Dancers provide sneak peek of show

A dance troupe, The Halton Dancers, are off to Holland in early October for nine days to visit a school and dance company in Doetinchem, near Arnhem.

The Halton Dancers, comprised of 20 members of the Halton Hills School of Dancing, was formed after receiving an invitation about two years ago to visit Holland. The invitation was extended by a dance group, Lefamm, which had visited Georgetown.

The Halton Dancers, led by artistic director Yvonne Oldaker, principal of the Halton Hills School of Dancing, are rehearsing for a joint performance with the Lefamm company. The performance will include a variation of the Dutch and Canadian national anthems danced by the two companies.

The dance troupe will give local residents a sneak peek in A Holland Celebration in the John Elliott Theatre this Friday, Sept. 29. After the show, there will be a reception to meet the performers in the

School Studios, 142 Mill St., Georgetown.

During the show, international renowned pianist Ronald Greidanus of Georgetown will accompany one of the dancers in a special dance, after which he will be performing a number of short piano pieces by Brahms, Chopin, Rachmaninoff and Dohnanyi.

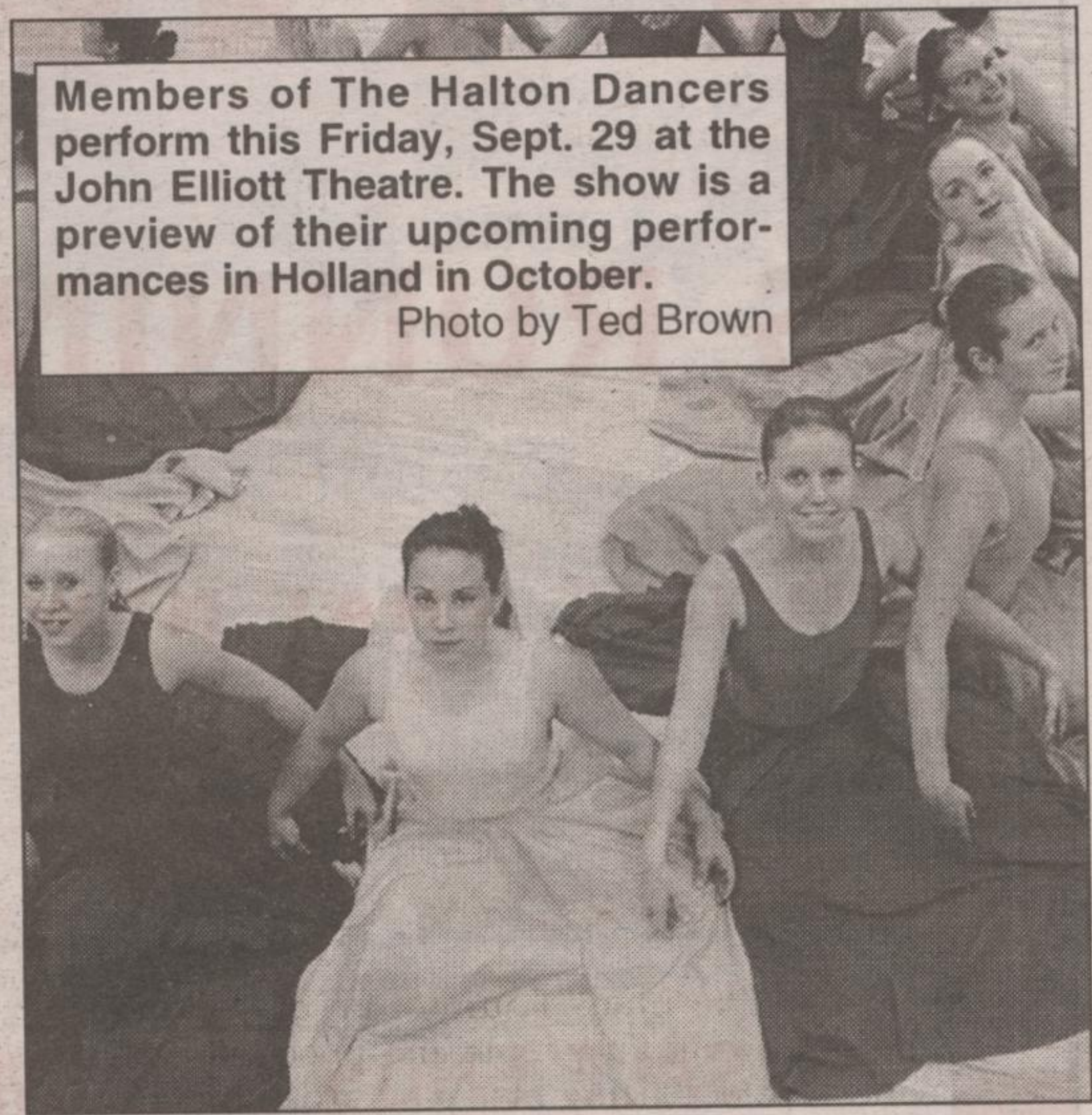
The Halton Dancers will also be performing at other

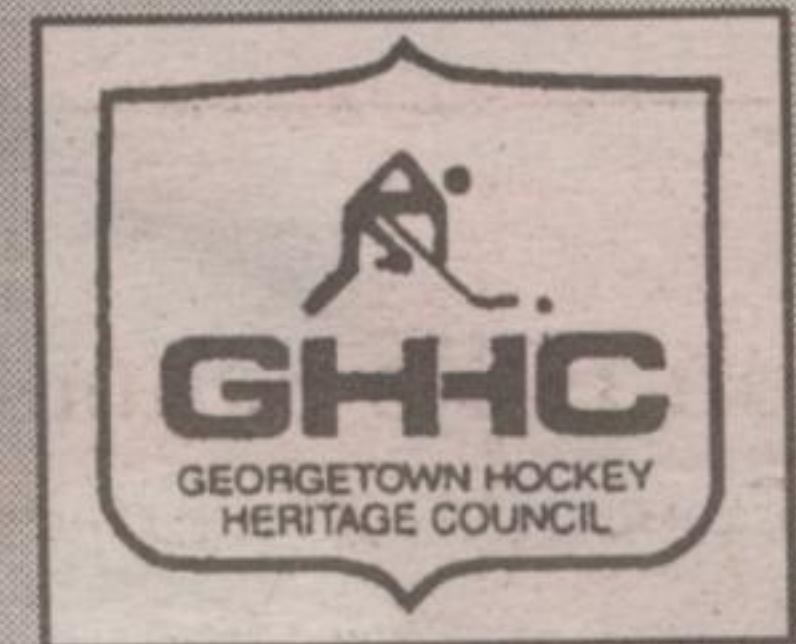
