



Cost for arena project comes in \$2 million higher than expected

"That leads us to believe the four bids are not truly competitive bids in this marketplace," said Andrews.

However, he said the high arena bids has the town concerned about tenders for the recreation centre.

Next month the town will be going to tender on that facility, which the town has estimated will cost \$8.1 million.

A total of \$2 million for both facilities is to be raised from the public and corporations through the localmotion fund-raising campaign. To date the campaign has raised \$1.75 million.

"I wasn't very happy," said Mayor Marilyn Serjeantson of the arena bids. SERJEANTSON

"(If you) look at the price of schools and hospital expansions, in the scheme of things our project is rather small," she said. "There's so much business out there you (contractors) can call your own tune so to speak."

Stover said staff is working on a report and recommendation to modify the facility to bring costs down

for Monday's council meeting.

"We're determined. We know we need both facilities (arena and recreation centre) and somehow we are going to make it work,"said Serjeantson.


Meeting date, group listed incorrectly


A headline concerning a region water information meeting in the October 18 edition listed an incorrect date.
