## Opening night nearing for GLT's first show of the season

Members of Georgetown Little Theatre are busy rehearsing and preparing the set for their opening production of the season, *On Golden Pond*.

Director Steve Prevost has selected a strong cast to perform this play, written by Ernest Thompson, which tells the love story of Ethel and Norman Thayer, who are returning to their summer home on Golden Pond for the 44th year.

He is a retiring professor, nearing 80, with heart problems and a failing memory, but still as tart-tongued, observant and eager for life as ever. Ethel, 10 years younger and the perfect foil for Norman, delights in all the small things in life. They are visited by their

divorced, middle-aged daughter and her dentist fiancé, who then go off to Europe, leaving his teenage son behind for the summer.

The production is playing at the John Elliott Theatre in the Halton Hills Cultural Centre on Nov. 2, 3, 4 and Nov. 8, 9, 10, 11. The Nov. 2 performance is a benefit for the Remembrance Park Millennium Project, and the Nov. 4 performance is a Gala Night to meet the cast/crew in the Gallery.
