Dedication to be held Saturday Remembrance Park is ready

After months of work, George-town's Remembrance Park has been renovated and will be dedicated this Saturday.

Martin Boomsma, chair of the Remembrance Park Millennium Steering Committee, said about 1:45 p.m. a parade featuring a George-town Legion Branch 120 Colour Party, Georgetown Girls Pipe Band, Acton Citizen's Band, American Legion Post 40 Colour Guard from Plymouth, Massachusetts, scouts, guides and veterans will make its way from the legion to the park for the 2 p.m. dedication ceremony.

Boomsma said Reverend Peter Barrow will officiate at the ceremony and the cenotaph, which has been relocated to a more central location in the park, will be unveiled by two local veterans and two local elementary school children.

Following the ceremony, which will also include the Georgetown Children's Chorus, Georgetown Choral Society, Georgetown Pipe Band and local air and army cadets, everyone is welcome to attend Knox Presbyterian Church Hall for refreshments.

Boomsma is pleased with the park renovation.

"It's turned out beyond our expectations," he said. "I never imagined the park would look this nice."

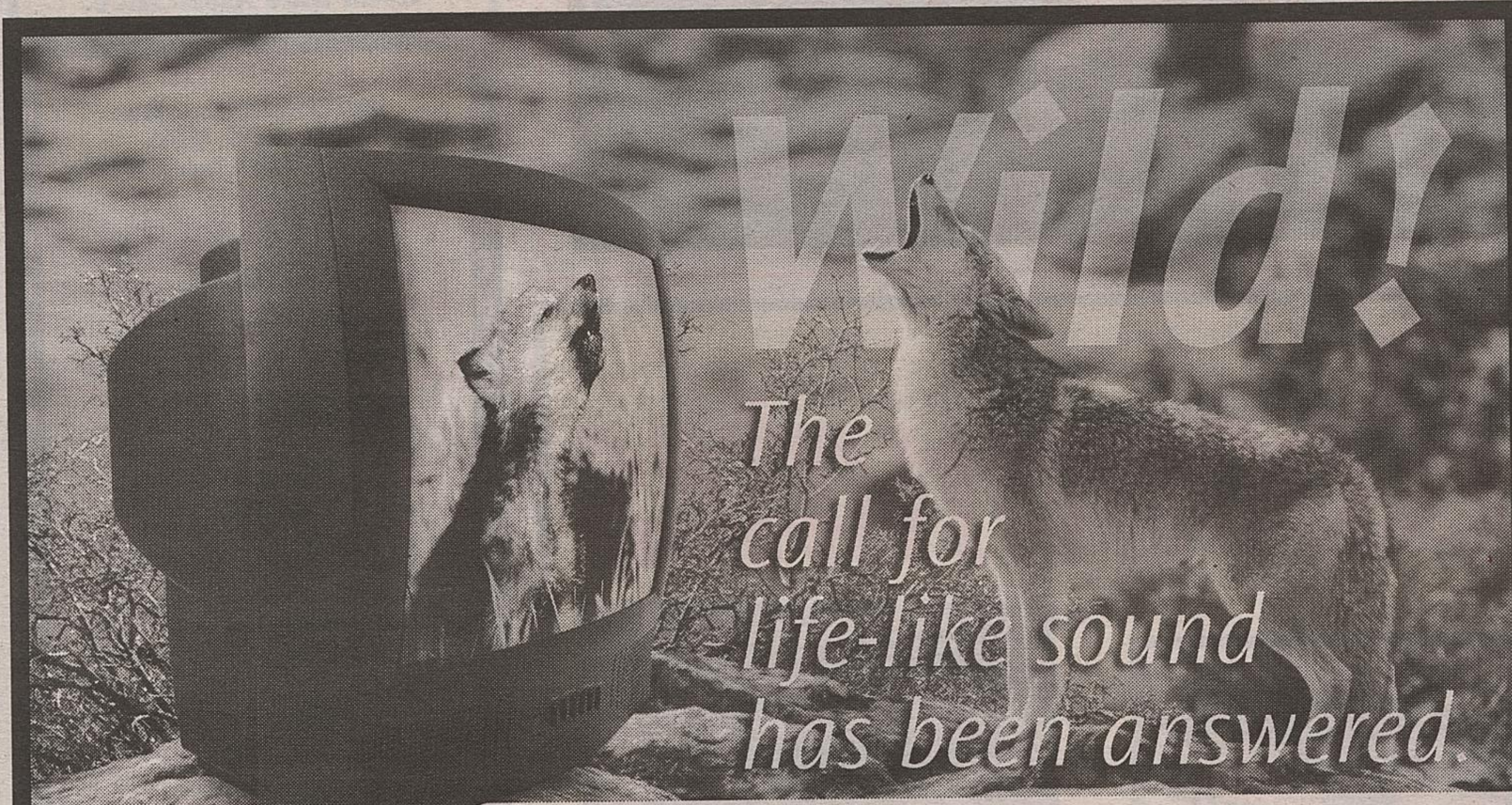
Work completed during the \$270,000 renovation of the park included refurbishing and relocating the cenotaph and installing a water feature at the base, installation of flag poles, hard surface gathering space and walkways, shade garden, white garden, commemorative gardens, shade pavilion, entry walls of natural stone and pedestrian level lighting.

Boomsma said nearly all the work was done by local people and many volunteers had a hand in the success of the project.

"Everybody has shared the load."

"The response from the public has been fantastic," said Boomsma.

Police seek three youths after cabbie assaulted

A cab driver received serious facial and eye injuries after he was hit in the face with a beer bottle early Saturday.

Halton Police say about 12:45 a.m. the Georgetown Taxi cab driver was dropping off three young males in the Kingham Rd. area. One of the youths got out of the car, the second got out and said he was going to get money for the fare and when the driver turned to face the third male he was hit with the bottle.

All three fled.

The cab driver, a 47-year-old Oakville man, was taken to Georgetown hospital by ambulance, treated and released.

"The injuries to this cab driver are significant. We are currently seeking out the two witnesses who were in the cab prior to the assault," said Detective Sgt. Jackie Gordon. They are urged to call 878-5511 ext. 2105, ext. 2415 or Crime Stoppers at 1-800-222-TIPS.

Gordon added the occupants of the cab, who had been picked up on Trafalgar Rd., were seen by police when they passed through a RIDE spot check.
