Halloween is named UNICEF Day

In addition to the annual haul of candy, Halton Hills trick or treaters will be col-Llecting for UNICEF again this year.

For the first time, Halloween, Oct. 31, has been declared National UNICEF Day in perpetuity by the Canadian government.

The 2000 campaign goal across Canada is \$4 million— primarily raised by the nearly two million Canadian children expected to participate on Halloween night.

All proceeds support UNICEF (United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund) programs to help 78 million children in more than 150 developing countries. In the past decade UNICEF has helped bring safe water to 3.3 billion people, boosted the enrolment of school age children, especially girls and raised to 80 per cent global immunization levels against deadly childhood diseases.

Small change can do a lot:

• 25 cents will immunize three children against measles;

• 36 cents will provide 18 vitamin A cap-

sules to protect nine children against blind-

- 50 cents will buy oral rehydration salts to treat and restore to health six infants suffering from diarrhea and dehydration;
 - 80 cents will buy four boxes of chalk;
- 88 cents will buy 10 dozes of oral polio vaccine;
- \$1 will buy enough measles vaccine to immunize 12 children, 10 school books, three packets of lettuce seeds for a school or community garden or 20 litres of clean drinking water;
- \$2.35 will buy one education kit containing chalk, slate, eraser and a plastic carrier bag;

• \$2.80 will buy 20 cakes of soap;

• \$5 will buy 100 water purification tablets.





QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q: I believe that I require new dentures but I'm concerned how my appearance will be changed?

A: At the Denture Clinic we always go through a "Wax Try-In" stage. The selected teeth are set up in a wax base and fitted in your mouth. You then have the opportunity to see, in a mirror, exactly how the denture will appear, before it is completed.

As the teeth are only in wax at this stage, we have the liberty to move the teeth about, or even change the particular tooth selection. We never go beyond this step until we have accomplished exactly the natural, pleasing appearance your desire.

Q: What is a permanent processed reline?

A: A processed reline is a way of re-basing your denture from the same type of long care acrylic from which it was originally made. This will make the denture fit more snugly to your ridge.

Q: Will it change the appearance of my teeth?

A: No, it only re-fits the denture to your ridge, no change of tooth position takes place.

Q: What are soft, or cushion relines?

A: A permanent soft rubber lining is applied to the lower denture inside ridge, soft, or cushion relines are excellent alternatives for those who have sensitive oral tissue and tend to get frequent sore spots. A properly applied soft lining can provide years of comfortable chewing and smiling. You do not need a referral; simply call our office direct.
