

Historical Society to hear re-telling of Hazel

There was an eerie silence in the air on October 15, 1954. The kind that seems innocent enough, but holds the very essence of panic and destruction.


Sure enough, Hurricane Hazel, traveling at a 30 miles per hour (50 km-h) clip, hit the village of Norval with almost no warning. With winds reaching 100 miles per hour (160 km-h), it left awesome flooding and destruction in its wake. It smashed the Noble grist mill and washed out dams. Hydro was out for more than four and a half hours.

Although most of the remainder


of this region was relatively unharmed, Hurricane Hazel will never be forgotten by those who experienced it.

Come see for yourself on Wednesday, Nov. 8, at 7 p.m. at Knox Church in Georgetown when the Esqueving Historical Society will be holding a meeting featuring the wrath of Hurricane Hazel. A presentation featuring photographs and a recording of an original radio newscast will be given by Steve Pitt.


As usual, the Society meeting is open to the public free of charge and refreshments will be served after the meeting.

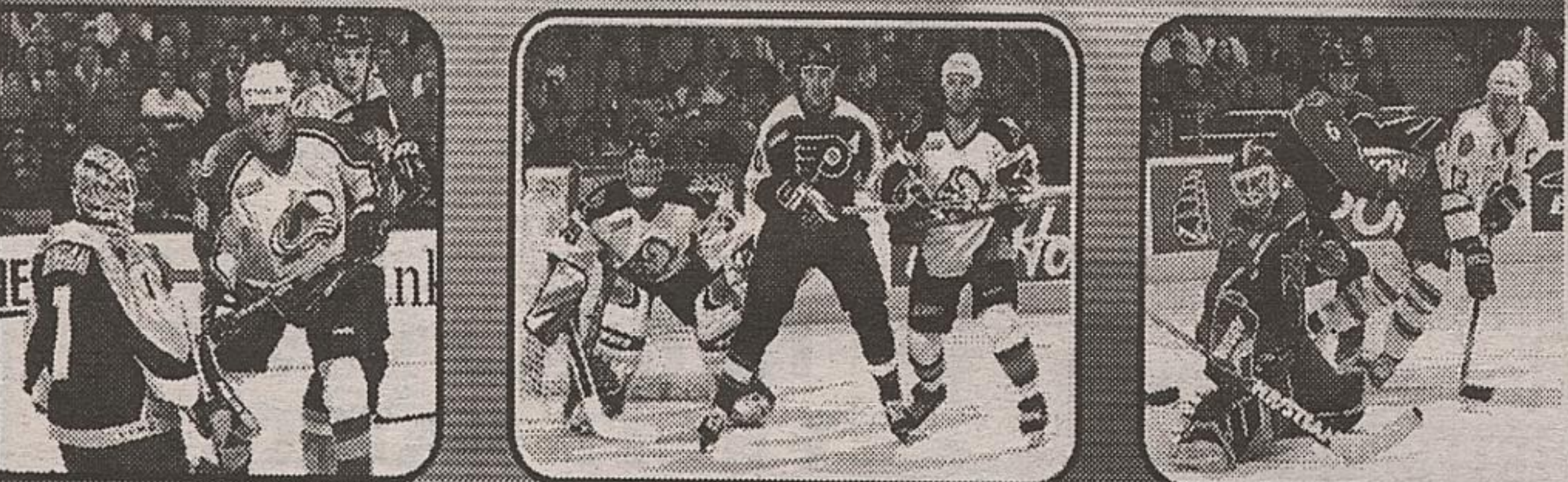
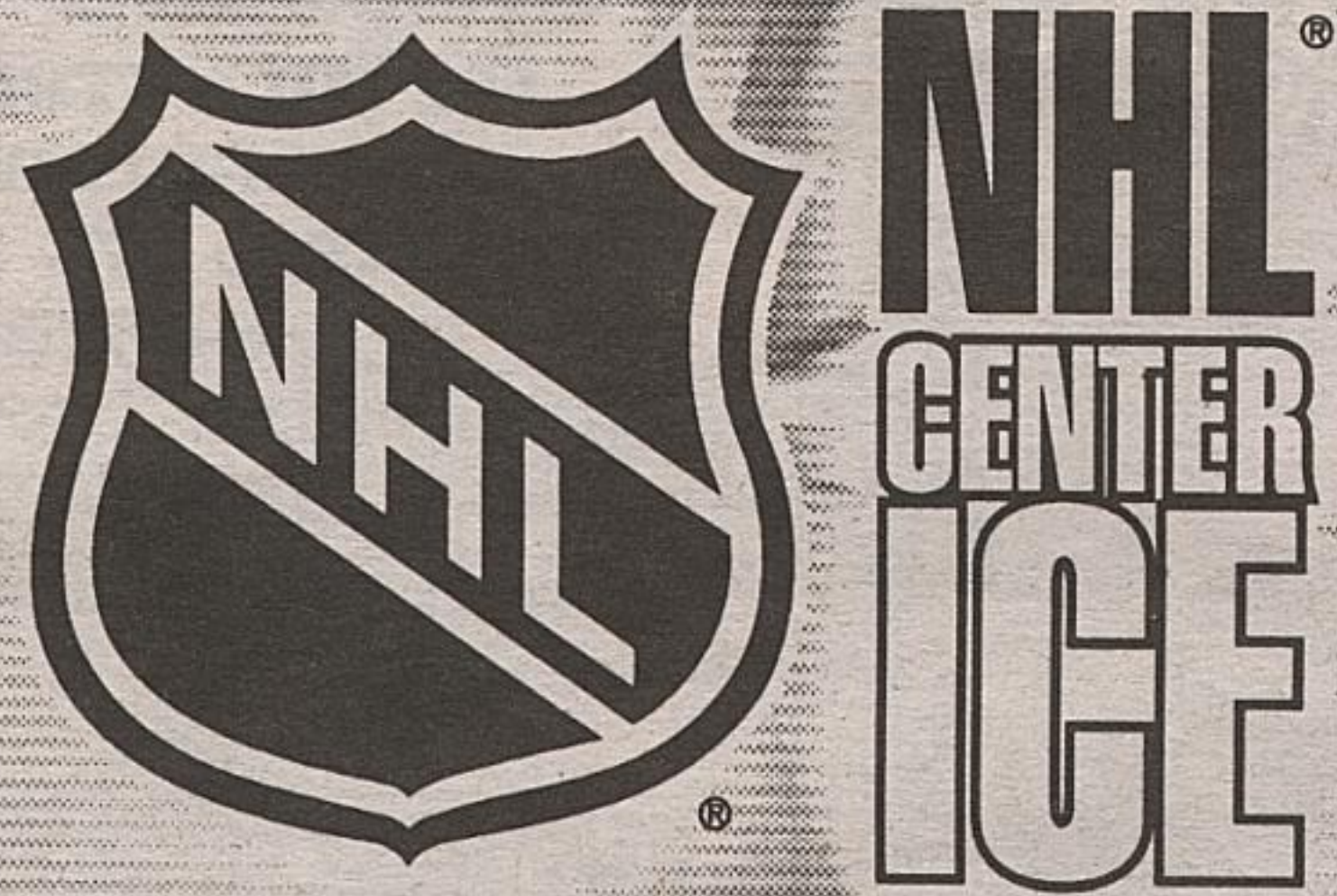

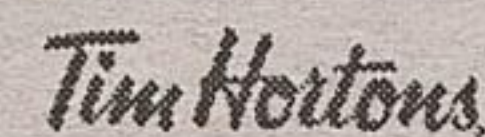
