Thieves sought

Parties nominate candidates for federal election

All parties have nominated their candidates for the November 27 federal election.

Long time Georgetown resident Tom Kilmer was nominated by the Halton Federal Progressive Conservative Riding Association in Milton Saturday.

Kilmer operates Kilmer Environmental in Mississauga and is a former director of the United Way of Halton Hills

and Halton Hills Chamber of Commerce.

Tim Dobson, the Canadian Alliance candidate, was selected at a nomination meeting in Milton Monday night.

Milton resident Dobson is manager of Ontario Power Generation's chemistry department. Local residents Clay Downes and Giuseppe Gori also vied for the nomination.

Retired school teacher Brenda Dolling

of Burlington is the NDP candidate in Halton. She was nominated at a meeting in Milton last Wednesday.

Oakville resident Tom Adams, a financial and business analyst, was announced as the Green Party candidate last Sunday.

Halton's current MP, Liberal Julian Reed is hoping for a third consecutive term in office.
