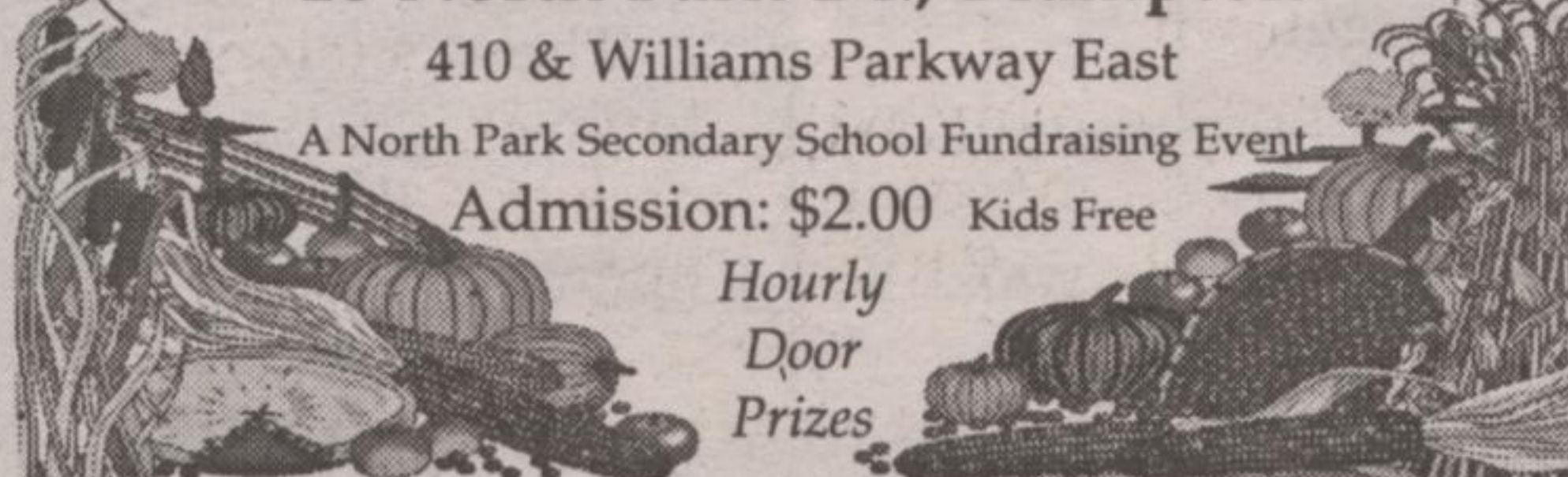

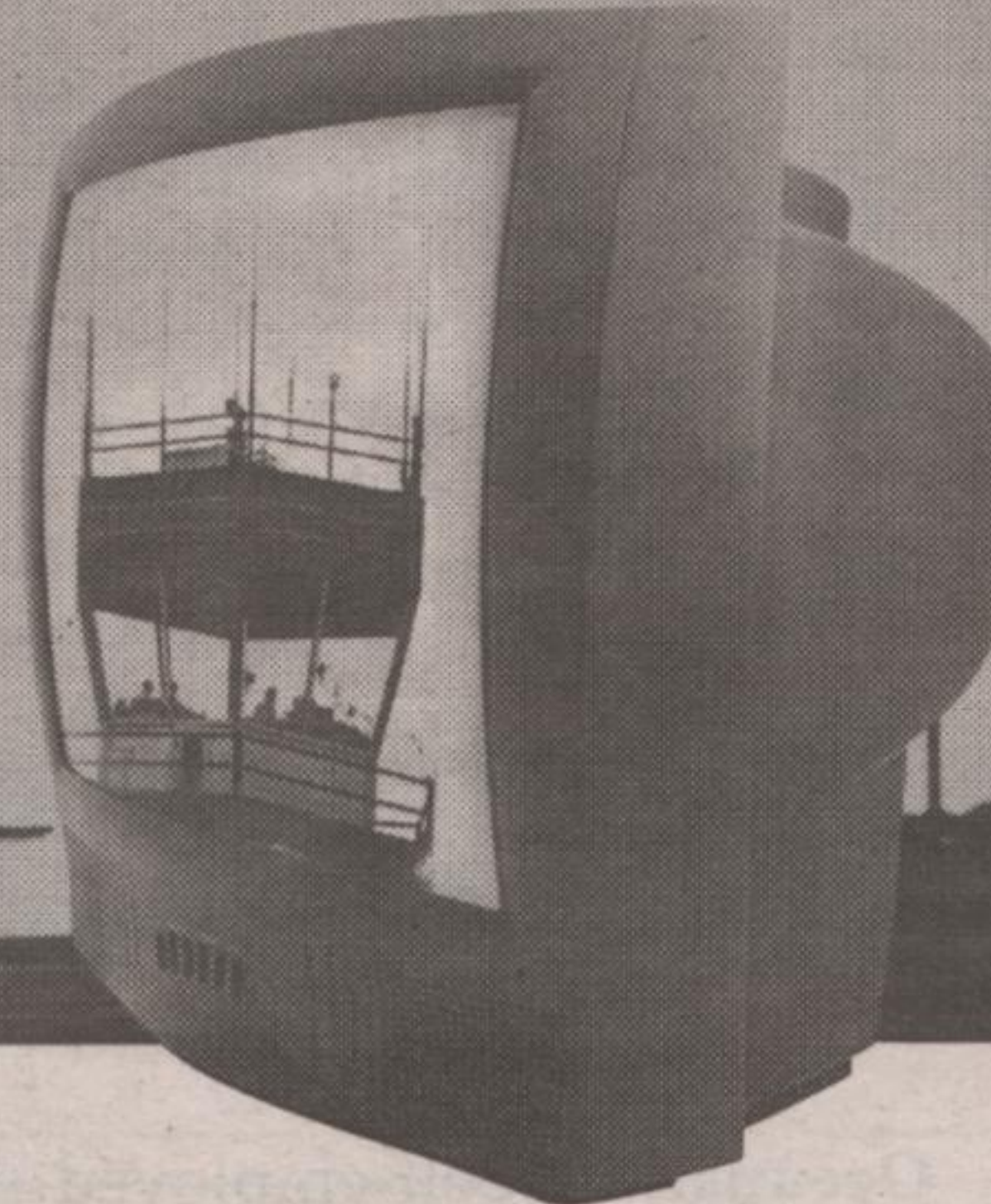
Paul McDougall
