provides the power to beam the signal to the satellite. What we'll be doing now is the rest of the car— the systems around it, the electronics and the control systems."

Caldarelli said he expects to be producing the amplifiers within six months and have the operation fully integrated within a year. CPI is also the world's largest independent supplier of electrical systems for medical X-ray imaging systems. More than 95 per cent of its products are exported and distributed worldwide.

The company has operated in Georgetown since 1955. Previously known as Varian Canada, it changed its name to CPI in 1995 when

employees in Georgetown.

Caldarelli said the company will fully utilize the basement of its 125,000 square foot facility on River

Road to accommodate the new operation. He expects it will have to expand in the future but for now the company has leased a 22,000 square

foot facility on Sinclair Avenue which it will use as a warehouse.

The decision to move to Georgetown was based on the cost of business in California and the pre-existing operation in Georgetown.

"It's a type of business that's very difficult to do in the Silicon Valley. It's very expensive and there is a large turnover," Caldarelli said. "We've already got good infrastructure in Georgetown and we understand the business and the technology."

Many of the new jobs will be highly specialized technical positions. CPI is doing a Canada-wide recruitment campaign but is also looking locally for positions that can be filled by people in the area.
