But no injuries reported Squall causes series of fender-benders

The snow squall that blew through town Wednesday caused problems for drivers on area roads and kept Halton Police officers busy with several minor accidents.

At 11:30 a.m. a Toyota slid in snow off the road on Hwy. 7 south of Trafalgar Rd. and hit guard rail posts.

Shortly before noon the driver of a Hyundai lost control on Main St. N near Henry St., spun around, and hit a fence on the east side of the road.

About 12:15 p.m. police were called to a two-car accident on Guelph St. near Rexway Dr. and about 12:50 p.m. responded to Guelph St. near Hall Rd. because a van went into the ditch and rolled over.

Another van rolled over on Hornby Rd. north of Steeles Ave. about 3 p.m. and about 7 p.m. a Mazda hit three mailboxes and ended up in the ditch on Trafalgar Rd. south of 15 Sideroad after the driver attempted to avoid an ice patch on the road.

No one was injured in the accidents.
