Charleston's Charlie Kuiken, a custom builder, selected Rockwood for its tranquil setting to build distinguished homes of classic comfort, contemporary style and gracious appointments.

Kuiken grew up in the area and knows firsthand of the benefits of country living. His years of exacting craftsmanship are evident in the home designs and quality appointments, and he is always pleased to customize a home to its owner's discriminating tastes and needs. Evidence of his high standards is found at his other sites which include Palamino Ranch in Carlisle, Erin Meadows in Erin, Deer Ridge in Kitchener, Glen Williams on the shores of the Credit River in Georgetown, and just a few blocks away

in Rockwood within the detached homes of Mill Run. Always conscious of energy efficiency, Charleston Homes is an R-2000 builder.

Construction is now underway at River Walk where six floor plans exhibit refreshing designs that combine the practicality and spaciousness of a lofted bungalow with interi- ment) of open-concept design, light-filled spaces and inherent versatility. These qualities, along with charming traditional details, are brought to the forefront within two adjoining model homes that characterize the high level of finishing detail that can easily be attained in a Charleston They home. appointed with vaulted ceilings, optional sky-



lights, arched windows and boxed bay windows, plant shelves, decorative ceiling finishes and one-piece acrylic tub and shower units. Colonial trim, oak railings, decorative columns, ceramics and 40-ounce carpeting enhance the innovative space within. The loft area is also open to individual design for those who prefer an open plan or those requiring separate rooms for more privacy on the upper level.

Stroll along the interlocking brick driveway and adjoining walkway (standard features) and into the model home of The Old Mill. At 1,620 sq. ft., it admirably demonstrates many of these features, in addition to its spectacular open-concept Great Room complete with vaulted ceiling, plant shelves and skylights. The open loft overlooking the main floor can be further customized with an additional bedroom and full bathroom.

When a finished basement is considered (at a cost of \$13,080 to \$20,490, depending on the plan selected) the living space of this home can be doubled to offer plenty of room for visiting family members and grandchildren.

Next door is the model home of The Forge, a smaller home of 1,475 square feet but every bit as captivating, with its vaulted great room immediately adjacent to its generously-sized entry foyer. A bright kitchen enjoys access to the patio. Deep windows are found throughout lending an increased air of spaciousness.

Several purchasers have opted to create a master suite in the openness of the

loft area and so Charleston Homes is offering one of its own designs. Under construction is The Grange, a one-of-a-kind home that will be ready for occupancy in mid-December. This home is located on a riverside lot and will be adorned with special features such as a great room lit by skylights, a walk-in pantry, a separate dining room area and double-car garage.
