
PUBLIC MEETING

NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING Ward 2/Queen Street (Hwy. 7) and Churchill Road

General Committee for the Town of Halton Hills will conduct a Public Meeting to examine and discuss proposed amendments to the Town of Halton Hills Official Plan and Zoning By-law 1358, as amended by Zoning By-law 95-095. The purpose of the amendments is to permit an additional 10,000 square feet in ground floor area for the supermarket, a reduction in the number of parking spaces and in the size-of the loading space. The property is currently vacant with site plan approval for a commercial plaza with a supermarket and retail component. The subject property is located on Part of Lot 27, Concession 4, Part Lot 335, Registered 20R-10210 in Acton.

The public is invited to attend the meeting to ask questions and provide comments. If a person or public body files an appeal of the decision of the Town of Halton Hills, in respect of the proposed Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendments, and does not make oral oral submissions at a public meeting, or written submissions, to the Town of Halton Hills before the proposed Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-law Amendment are adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.
