**Progress update on Dominion Gardens:
 Objections to retail site withdrawn**

Objections by Loblaw's and a local plaza owner to a proposed commercial area on the Dominion Gardens site in Georgetown have been withdrawn, Halton Hills council members were told recently.

This paves the way for the confirmation of the zoning and Official Plan amendments for the commercial area which will include a large supermarket, restaurants and smaller retail stores. The town's planning staff is now awaiting revised site plans from the developer.

As well, a portion of the four-acre high density site (at the corner of Maple Ave. and Mountainview Rd.) is currently in the application stage of being rezoned for 40 to 50 townhouses which still leaves 1.5 acres for high density (apartments). "My concern is that so much time was spent to secure that 4.3 acres for the high density; we went through a public process," said Georgetown Councillor Ron Chatten. "If we give that away, then where is it going to be located?"

Final approval on the application will come back to council.
