on a goal with 28 seconds to play. Gary Hynes had a goal and an assist for the Ram Jammers.

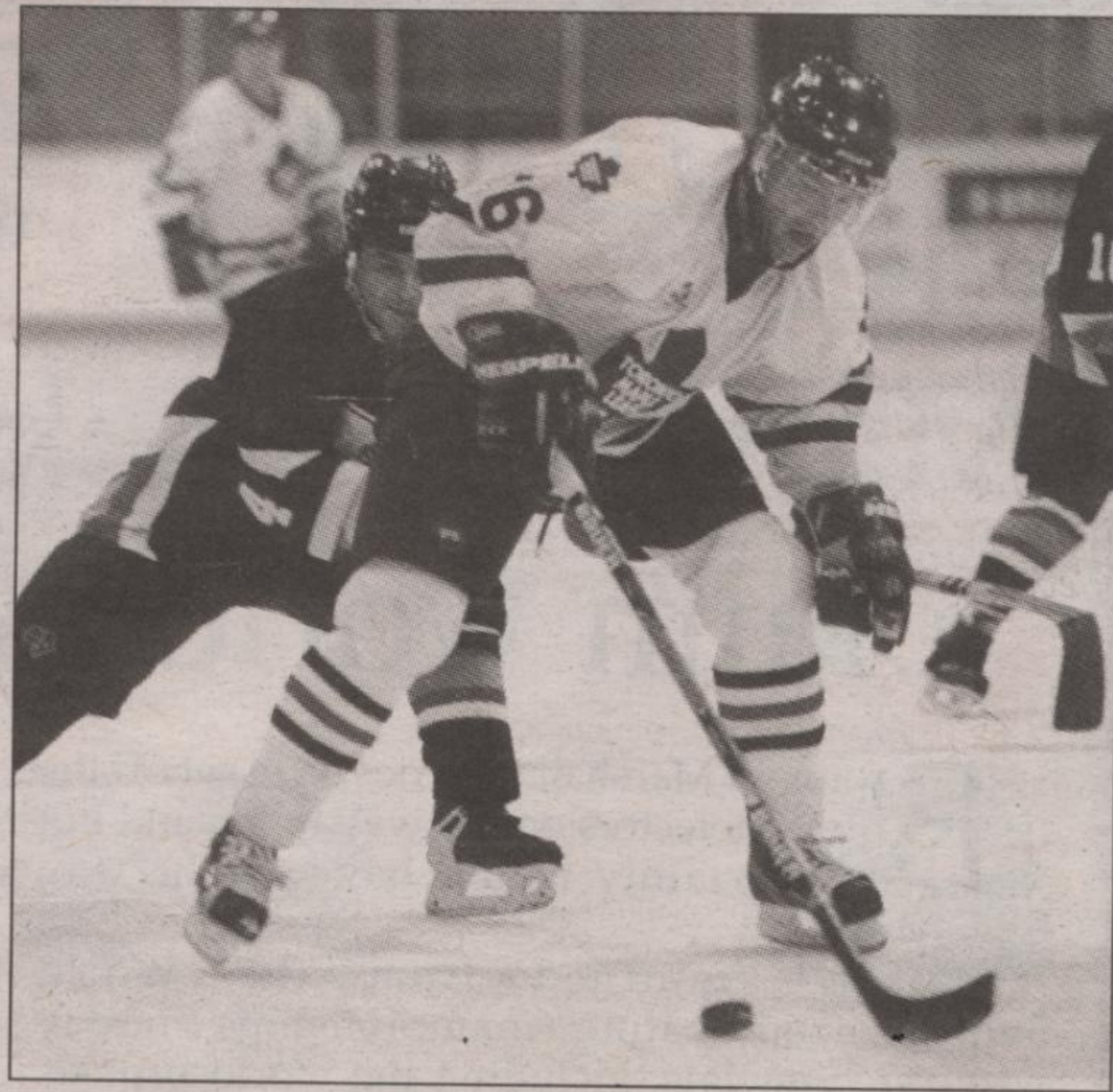
Don Armstrong's hat-trick and a five-point game by Joe Ens paced RPI to a 7-2 win over Western in the Can-Am Alumnists Division final.

North Halton rink finishes third at bantam bonspiel

Alex Foster and Peter Gorski earned themselves a second top-three finish at provincials while rinkmates Taylor Gabel and Chad Skinner earned themselves some valuable experience.

The North Halton rink tied for third at the bantam boys curling championships in Ennismore. They finished with a 4-3 record to meet their goal of winning at least half their games.

One of their losses came against the champion Sarnia rink, which

was a perfect 7-0. Another was a close one-point loss to Niagara Falls, which finished second at 6-1.

"The competition was really good but there was no team we couldn't compete with," said Gabel.

Foster and Gorski had gone to the Ontario mixed bantam championship earlier this year.

"It helped a lot knowing what to expect and having the playing experience at that level," Gorski said.

They recognized several players, who like themselves, had been at the mixed championship, including two

members of the winning rink from Sarnia.

While Foster and Gorski will move up to the junior level next year, both Gabel and Skinner will have at least two more years remaining in bantam. They've already seen the benefits from their first provincial experience.

"Just over the last month, practising so much more, I've doubled my skills and learned so much about the game," Gabel said. "I've improved tremendously."
