Kiss Me Kate opens tomorrow at the JET

Georgetown Globe Productions ends its 2000-2001 season with the Cole Porter musical classic, *Kiss Me Kate*, opening at the John Elliott Theatre, tomorrow night (Thursday).

Globe first did this show in 1987 and its popularity can be seen in that it is now enjoying a long run revival on Broadway.

This fast-paced classic involves a play-within-a play as actors in 1948 Baltimore prepare to open a produc-

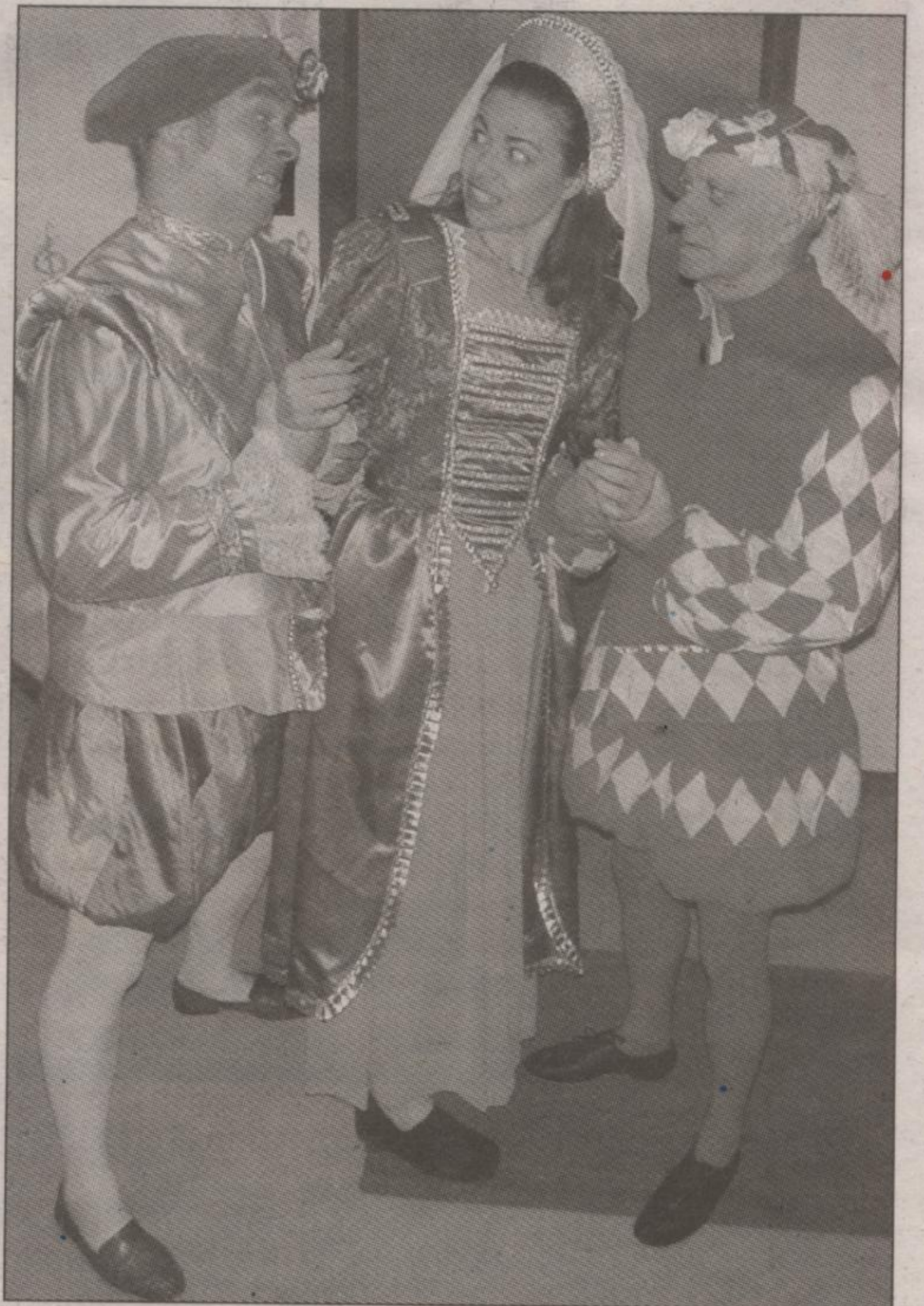
tion of Shakespeare's *Taming of the Shrew*. A bickering show business couple (played by Mark Llewellyn and Linda Spence) encounter two bumbling gangsters (Eddie Plackett and Gord McLeod), a pair of young lovers (Chris Gawley and Paula Gonsalves) and a not so bright senator (Paul d'Entremont). General mayhem ensues as things heat up on (and off) stage.

The show has some wonderful Porter classics such as *Too Darn Hot*, *Another Op'nin, Another Show* and *Wunderbar*.

The production team are all award winners in local theatre. Jacki Willows (Camelot) is artistic director, ably assisted by choreographer Cheri Lindsay-Jarvis (West Side Story) and musical director Michael Domet (Annie).

The show opens tomorrow (May 3) at the John Elliott Theatre— a wine and cheese meet the cast gala follows in the gallery.

The show continues Friday and Saturday (May 4-5) and May 10-12 at 8 p.m. and at 2 p.m. on May 6 and 12. Tickets are \$15 for Thursdays and matinees and \$17 for Fridays and Saturdays. Call the Box Office at 905-877-3700.
