Acton athletes advance

Dawn Brunschwiler won two events at the Golden Horseshoe Athletic Conference Track and Field Championships to lead a team of 11 Acton High School athletes into the regional championships.

Brunschwiler won the midget girls triple jump with a distance of 8.74m, just short of the school record she set earlier this year. She also took first place in the midget girls 400m with a time of 66.19 seconds. She also qualified for regionals with a fifth-place finish in long jump.

Courtney MacGillivray also earned herself a GHAC title with a throw of 21.59m in the midget discus. She will also move on to regionals in javelin, where she finished fifth.

Laura Anne Sheehan advanced to regionals in three events. She cleared 1.3m to place second in the senior girls high jump at GHAC and was also fourth in triple jump and fifth in long jump.

Troy Ethier won a GHAC silver medal in the midget boys triple jump with a jump of 10.86m. He advances to regionals after a fourth-place finish in the long jump.

Steve Spiers placed second in the junior boys triple jump with a distance of 10.22m.

Jackie Christie is headed to regionals in two events. Her jump of 4.26m placed her second in the senior girls long jump. She was also fifth in the 200m.

Dawn Stevenson was third in the midget girls long jump with a distance of 8.45m.

Acton's other qualifiers for regionals are: Meghan Colvin (fourth, junior girls long jump); Krista Kearns (fourth, junior girls shot put and discus); Alicia Roza (fifth, midget girls 1500m), Emma Webster (fourth, senior girls 100m hurdles).
