Wm. Osler Health Centre to get extra \$17.6 million

Tilliam Osler Health Centre's share of the \$450 million allocated to Ontario hospitals is \$17.6 million.

The provincial government made the announcement last week.

"It's good news for us," said William Osler's V.P. Finance and Corporate Services, Vicki Truman. "It's additional income that's being added into our base."

The additional funding boosts the health centre's annual base budget by nearly 10 per cent to a total of \$202 million.

The recent funding allocation takes into account the growing population William Osler Health Centre

serves and provided about \$1.5 million for their renal dialysis priority program.

"Funding allocated to hospitals this year will reach \$8.6 billion. That's the highest base funding ever provided to Ontario hospitals."

The funding announcement from the province means Ontario hospitals now receive 5.5 per cent more base funding than last year, and 28 per cent more than five years ago.

"We want to make sure that hospitals have the means to provide the level of services that Ontarians trust and depend on," said Ontario Health Minister Tony Clement.

Storm causes power loss in Acton
