

## Peewee Eagles down Brantford

**S**hawn Dunsmore had two hits, including a double, as the Halton Hills Major Peewee Eagles doubled Brantford 4-2.

Dunsmore also drove in a pair of runs and Dustin Roskam went 2-for-3 with a run.

Brandon Stewart allowed only one run over five innings for the win while Dunsmore earned the save.

Stewart scored the winning run on Matthew Scott's sacrifice fly in the bottom of the seventh as the Major Peewee Eagles edged Waterloo 3-2.

Brett Neumann's two-run single in the sixth put the Eagles up 2-1 but Waterloo tied the game in the top half

of the seventh. Dunsmore pitched a complete game, striking out seven and not allowing a walk.

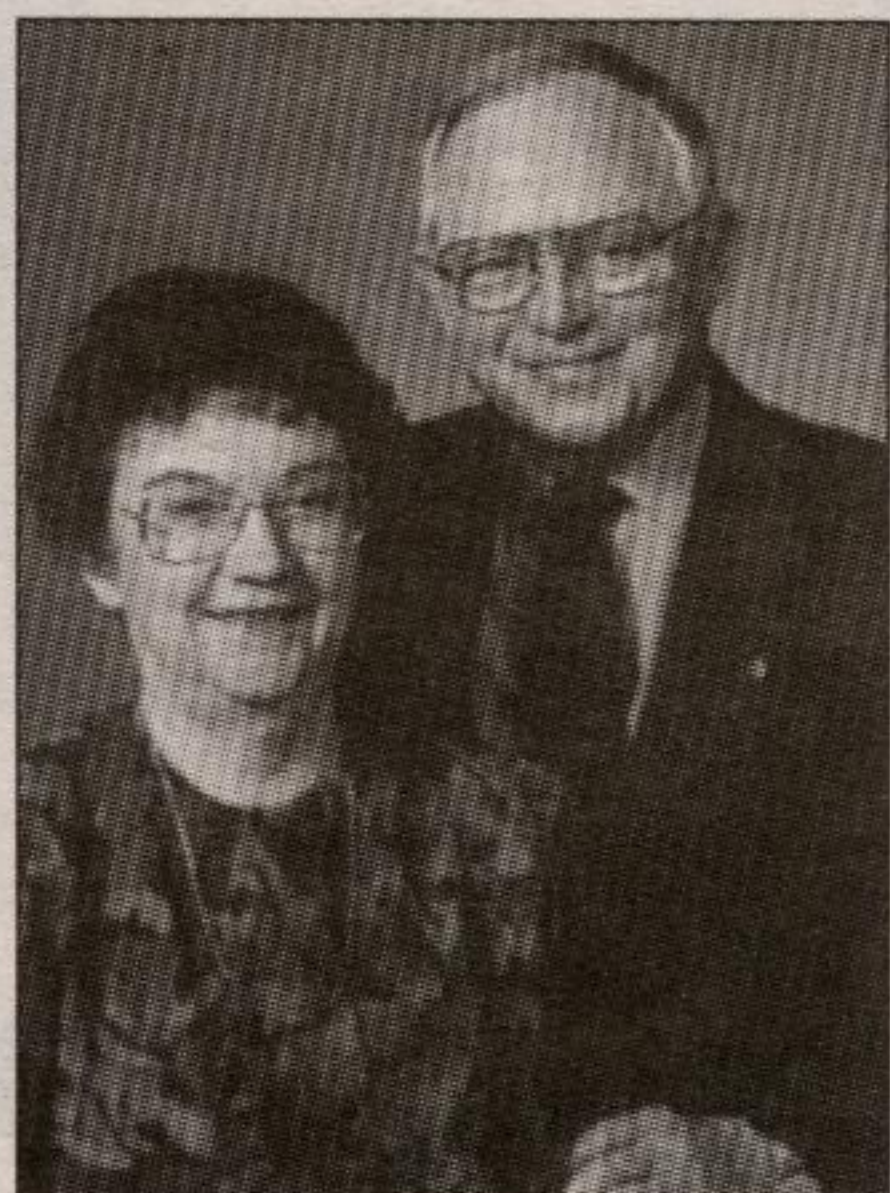

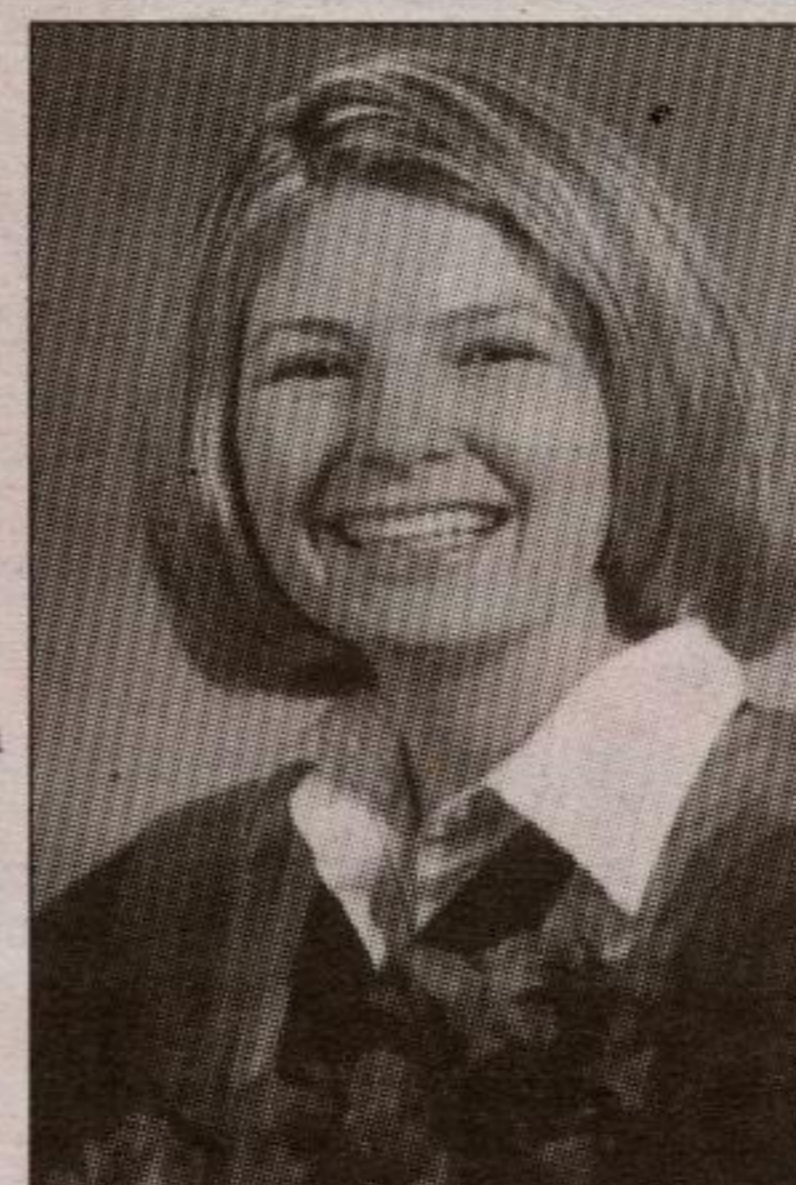
