Paddling for a cure

Acton's Ruth Kranendonk (left) was joined by Josey Murray of Acton BIA as they discussed the route Kranendonk is taking as she joins the Paddle to a Cure— Voyage of Hope, in aid of the Canadian Breast Cancer Foundation. Kranendonk left Killarney Provincial Park Wednesday morning, and will be paddling her kayak 120 km during the seven day trip, which includes camping out each night. Kranendonk was inspired to take part after reading in *The Independent & Free Press* about the involvement of two other Halton Hills women (Ruth Knight-Bowes and Susanna Hunter). The trip is dedicated to the memory of her twin sister Rosslyn Walker, who died from breast cancer in February. Originally, Kranendonk was expected to raise \$2,500 from pledges, but has surpassed \$7,000, due to donations from local individuals and businesses. Acton BIA donated \$385 toward the cause.

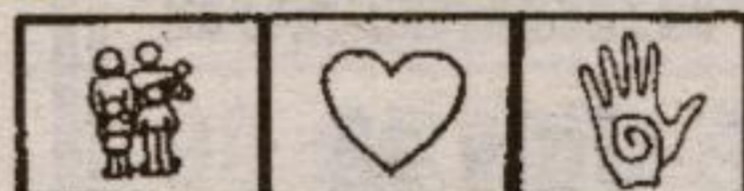
