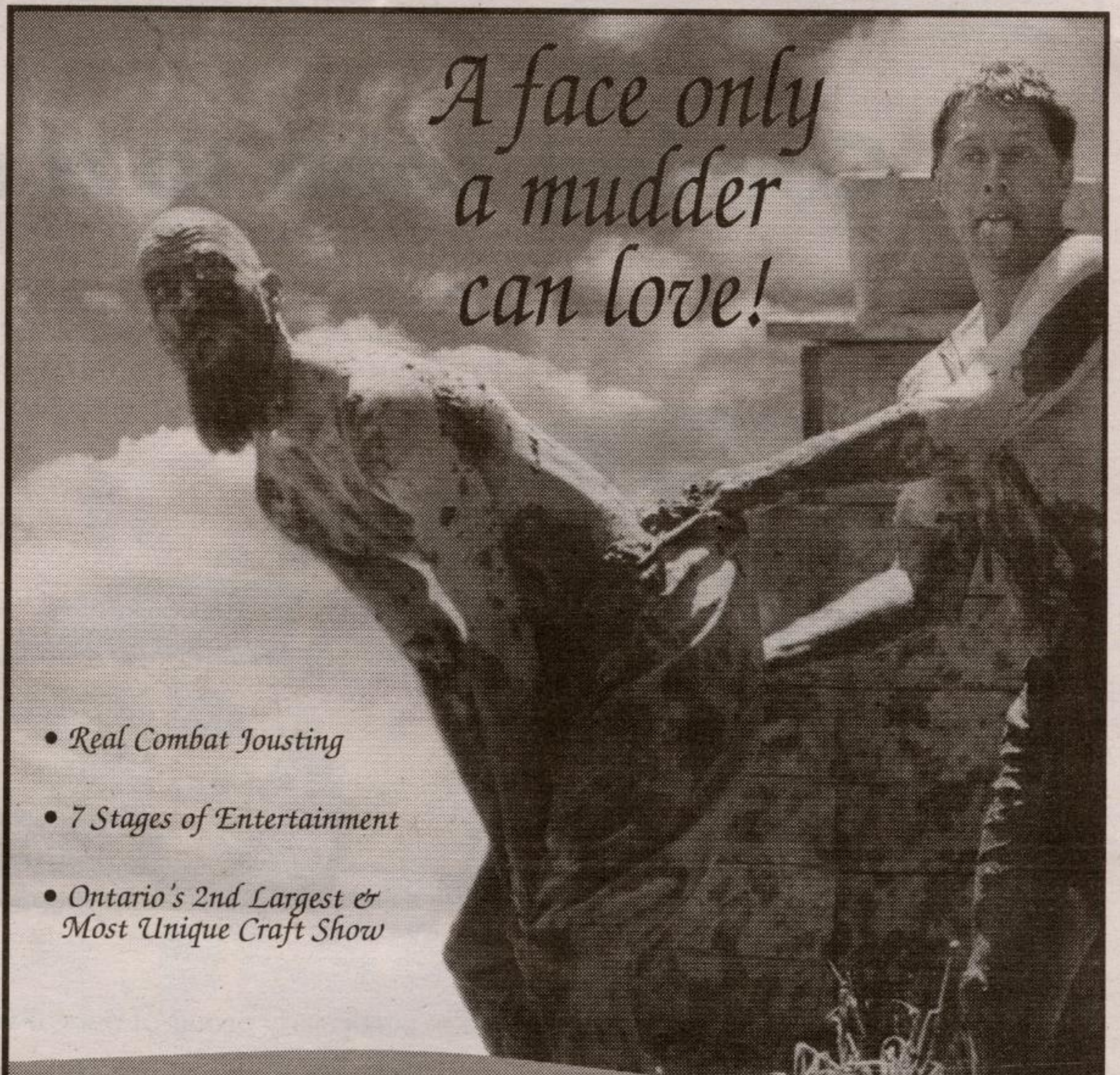
OUTDOOR WATER USE BAN
