

At JET Elvis tribute artist performs Saturday

Elvis lives, and he's coming to Georgetown.

Elvis tribute artist, Stephen Kabakos, winner of the Images of the King 2001 World Championship in Memphis, will be at the John Elliott Theatre Saturday, Sept. 15 at 8 p.m. as the Halton Museum Foundation, in association with AM740 prime time radio and Branthaven Homes presents The Way It Was.

The show, part of the Hearthside Music Series, features Kabakos, backed by the TVB Players and the Memphis Sound, in a two-hour energy-filled tribute to the king of rock and roll.

With the use of authentic costumes, original instruments and vintage-style microphones, The Way It Was, document's Elvis Presley's career from the early Sun Studio recordings, through the army, movie and concert years.

Tickets for this one-night show are now on sale at the John Elliott Theatre box office (9 Church St.) or the 24-hour ticket line (905-877-3700). Tickets are \$23 for adults and \$20 for seniors.

An hour prior to the show and during the intermission Scotch Block Country Winery will host wine-samplings of their award-winning fruit wines in the adjacent art gallery.

"The crowd is going to leave the John Elliott knowing that they've had a great night out," he added.

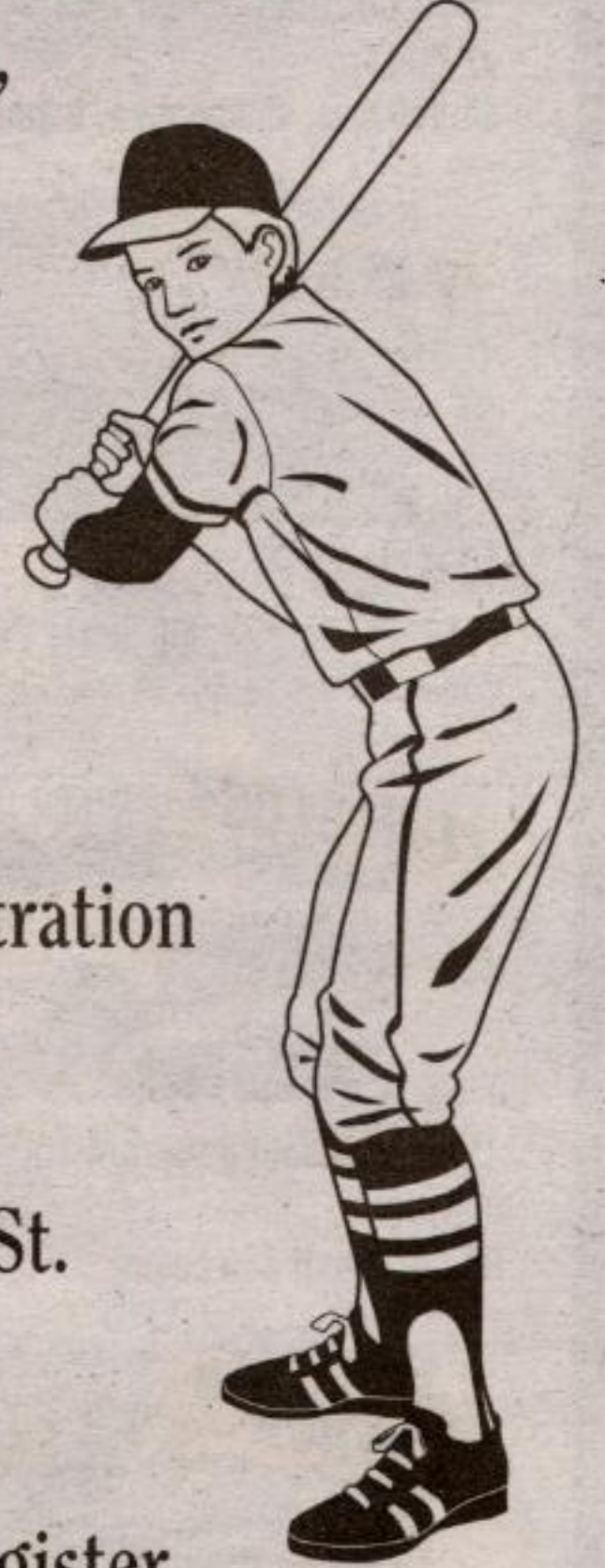

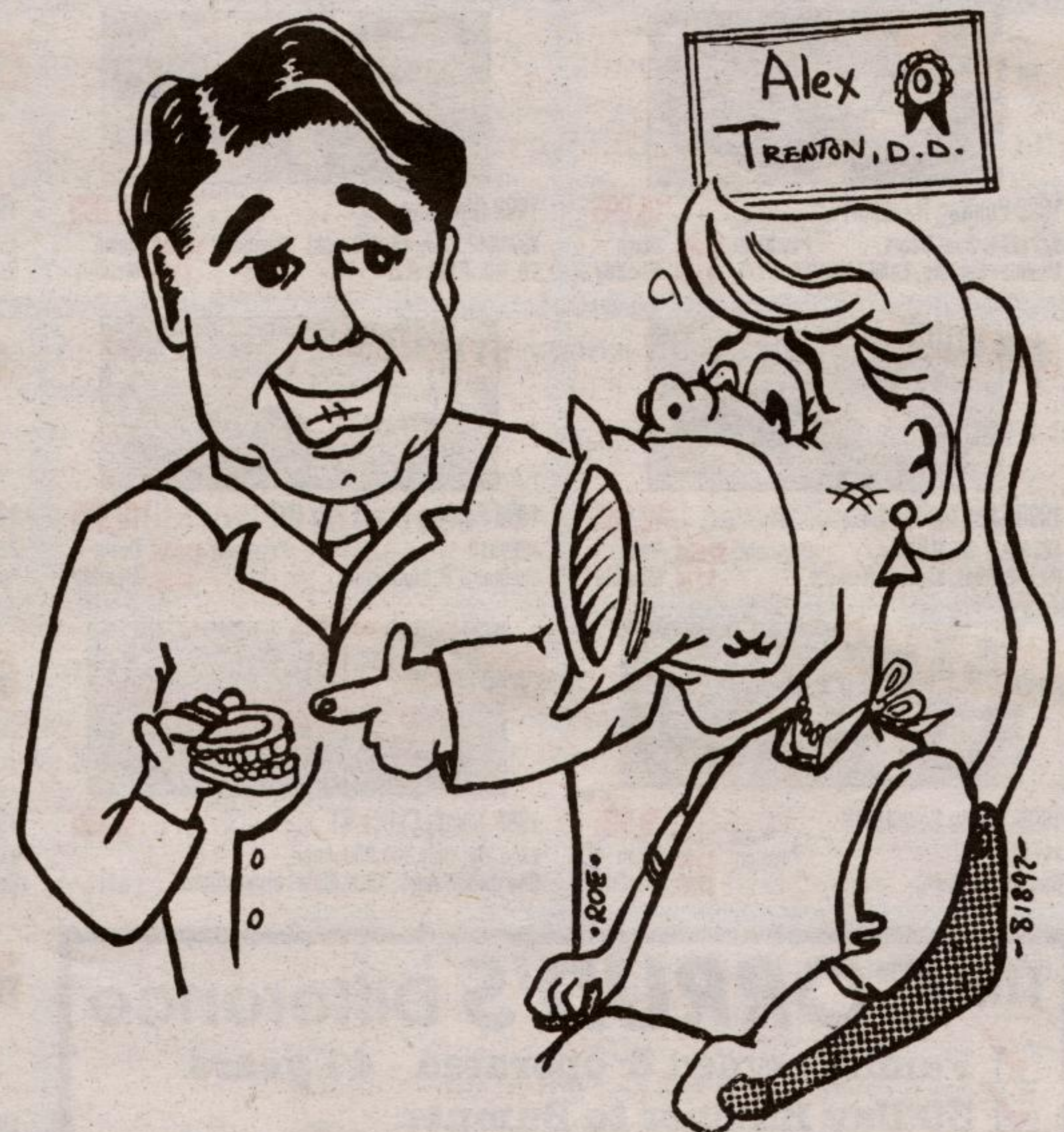
