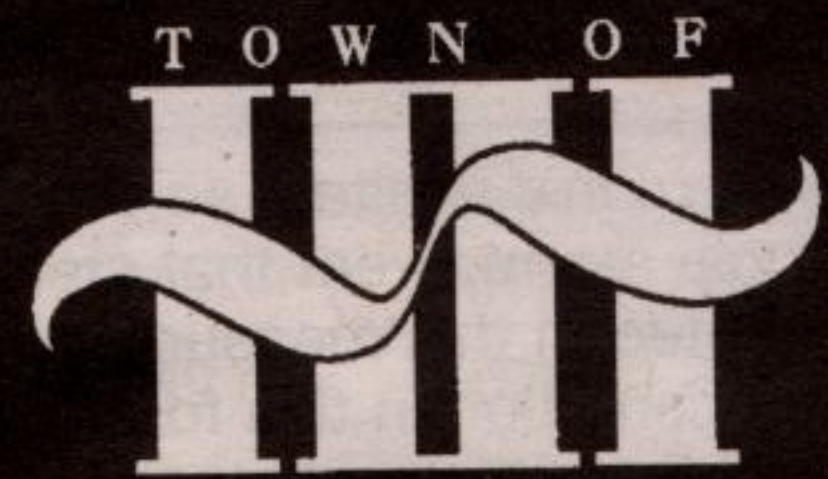

however, when Bobby's fiancée, Irene Roth, and the real Bela Zangler arrive in town.

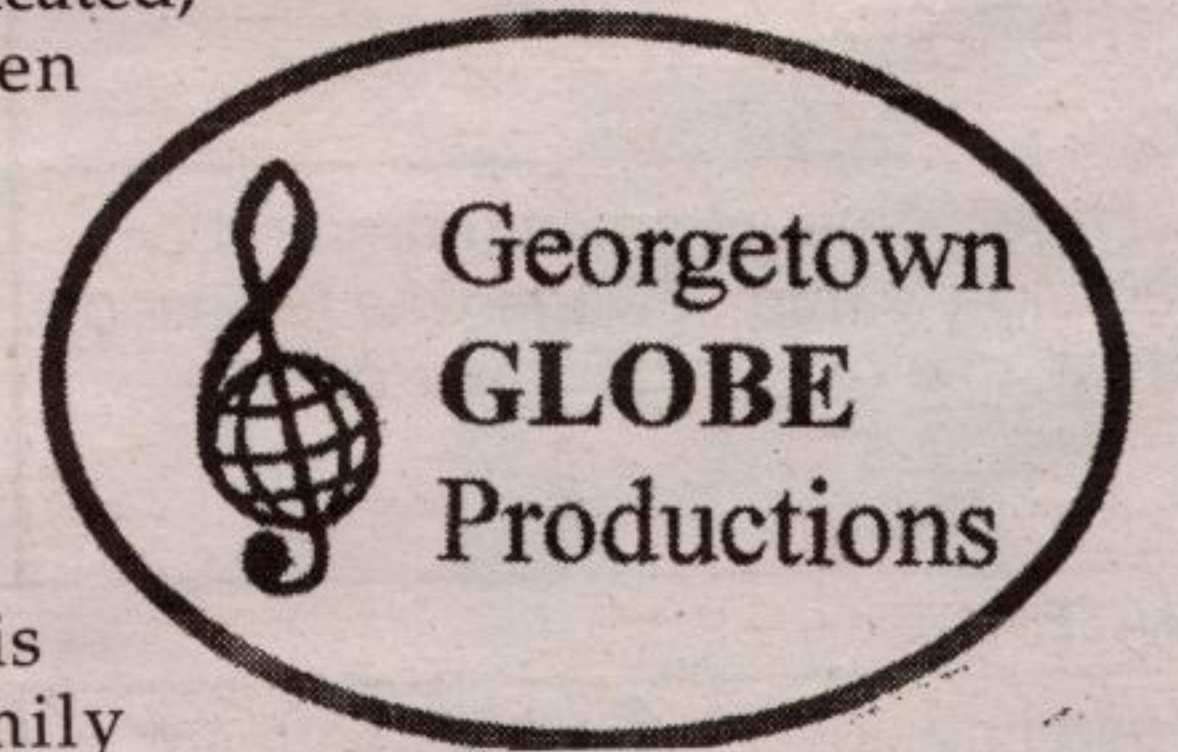

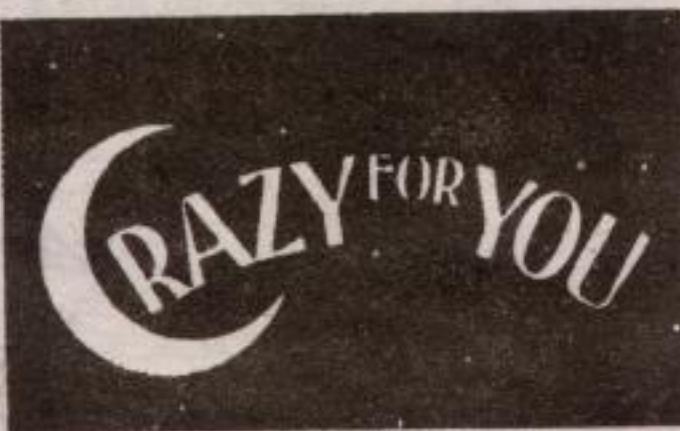
